Why We Don't Baptize Babies

- There is no biblical practice or teaching to do so (Acts 8:12).
 Jesus was baptized as an adult.
- Babies can't believe (Mark 16:16)
- Babies can't repent (Acts 2:38)
- Children are sanctified by the believing parent (1 Cor. 7:14)

Water baptism is a public declaration that a person has trusted Christ for his or her salvation. It is a personal identification with Jesus and represents his death, burial, and resurrection, as well as our own.
