Each year CPS awards placements in this program to students

working towards degrees aligned with food safety; many of the recipients support CPS funded research projects. The program lasts for three months with the PDP participants receiving:

- One-on-one private meeting with public or private sector senior executive of produce company
- Soft skills: Business communication (written, verbal, in person), professional dress
- Introduction and opportunity to present credentials and career goals to a live audience at the CPS Research Symposium.
- Invitation to Produce Safety Opportunities Breakout Session with several leaders and innovators in the produce safety industry.
- Opportunity to interact directly with private and public sector scientists and executives throughout the Symposium. Recipients will also learn and assist in coordinating production of the Symposium.
- Air travel and three nights lodging to attend the 2025 CPS Research Symposium
