Any dog requiring medical attention will be taken to their primary veterinarian or the closest emergency vet clinic. Charges will be at the owner's expense. Every effort will be taken to contact the owner or emergency contact prior to treatment. By signing this contract, you agree that any veterinary care expenses will be covered by the dog's owner.

We reserve the right to deny admittance to pets that lack proof of required vaccinations (rabies, Bordetella, and distemper), pets displaying signs of untreated or potentially contagious health conditions, and/or aggressive behaviour. We reserve the right to charge handling fees for excessively difficult or aggressive pets, requiring additional staff and/or additional time in order that we may deliver the proper care.

Entering or Leaving home and business:

Dogs that are too large to be carried safely must be healthy and confident enough to be able to go up and down a small set of stairs at the house entrance. I release Love at First Bark, it's owner operator, and any employees from any and all liability for damage, loss or injury that might be revealed, aggravated, caused, or worsened by navigating the stairs and entering/leaving the house.

Aggressive or Fearful Dogs:

The health and safety of your dog and our staff are the primary concerns of Love at First Bark. If your dog's caretaker feels his or her own safety, well-being or that of your dog is in jeopardy, a muzzle may be used or services refused / discontinued.

Cancellation Policy:

All boarding stays are booked with a maximum of 3 dogs in our care at a time to manage the quality of care and attention per dog. We understand that sometimes appointments need to be rescheduled, drop offs/pick ups rearranged. If this is needed, we reserve the right to deny your request depending on other bookings. Every effort will be made to accommodate whenever possible.

A non refundable 50% deposit is required at booking with the remaining amount due to be paid at drop off.
