In order to be eligible for the PRTAA Obedience Hall of Fame, dogs must have a UD and must also have either 5 legs towards their UDX, have accumulated 5 OTCH points or earned a TD. Proof of titles earned or competitive results must be submitted with application in the form of an AKC awards record.

In the event that an applicant is applying for a dog that is now deceased, the applicant need only provide evidence that the presently deceased dog was alive in a time period overlapping with the owner's membership in the PRTAA.

Additionally, Section II asks that applicants provide a photograph and short biography for the dog in question. The PRTAA reserves the rights to edit the contents of the submitted biography based on length or content.
