Cosmetic dentistry prioritizes enhancing the appearance and aesthetics of your smile. Common cosmetic dental procedures include teeth whitening, dental bonding, and veneers.


What's the difference between cosmetic dentistry and general dentistry?

A general dentist serves as your primary dental care provider, offering preventative care like teeth cleanings and restorative treatments such as dental fillings, crowns, and bridges. Most dental treatments focus on restoring both appearance and health. However, a cosmetic dentist specializes in refining your smile's appearance, offering treatments aimed at enhancing the aesthetics of your teeth and gums.

If you're considering enhancing your smile, cosmetic dentistry could be an appealing choice:

- Chipped or cracked teeth.
- Small gaps or spaces between your teeth.
- Tooth discoloration and staining.
- Misshapen teeth.
- Misaligned teeth.

As long as you have healthy teeth and gums, you can pursue cosmetic dental treatments. But if you have extensive cavities or gum disease, your dentist will want to address those conditions first. Once your smile is healthy again, you can decide which cosmetic treatments you want to explore.



What are examples of cosmetic dentistry?

Cosmetic dentistry strives to enhance smiles by achieving balance, symmetry, and aesthetic appeal. Common cosmetic dental procedures include teeth whitening, dental bonding, veneers, and tooth and gum contouring.



Cosmetic Dental Implants:

A dental implant serves as a permanent solution for replacing a missing tooth. Typically crafted from titanium, this metal device is surgically inserted into the jawbone at the site of the missing tooth. Functioning as an artificial tooth root, the dental implant provides stability for attaching artificial teeth like bridges or dentures (Up to 3 implants). Gum grafting, is included if needed, which is a surgical procedure often recommended to suport dental implants, particularly when there is insufficient gum tissue to adequately cover the implant post Bone grafting, also included, is a critical procedure in dental implantology, used to restore jawbone volume and density when insufficient bone exists to support implants due to tooth loss, periodontal disease, trauma,

Who is a candidate for cosmetic dentistry treatments?

If your teeth and gums are in good shape, you're likely a candidate for cosmetic dental procedures. However, if you're dealing with cavities or gum disease, we will prioritize addressing those issues before delving into cosmetic treatments. Once your oral health is restored, you can explore options like teeth whitening, dental bonding, veneers, and tooth and gum contouring to enhance the appearance of your smile.

Teeth Whitening:

Over time, consuming dark-colored foods and drinks such as coffee, tea, and berries can lead to staining on your teeth. Professional teeth whitening offers a safe and effective solution to lighten the shade of your teeth and enhance your smile.

Dental Bonding:

Dental bonding entails the application of tooth-colored composite resin. This material is skillfully used by your dentist to conceal and cover up various cosmetic imperfections like cracks, craze lines (hairline cracks), and discoloration. Additionally, dental bonding can alter the shape of a tooth to make it appear longer, wider, or more uniform.

Typically, dental bonding may need replacement every five to seven years. Moreover, it doesn't necessitate the removal of natural tooth enamel, making it a reversible procedure.

Cosmetic Dental Crowns:

Crowns, sometimes referred to as caps, are individually tailored to fit over your entire tooth. Typically composed of acrylic or porcelain fused to metal for durability against biting pressure, these custom-made crowns restore both the function and appearance of the tooth. Crowns are a versatile tool in cosmetic dentistry, employed to address various dental issues such as irregularly shaped teeth, significant decay, fractures, chips, or extensive fillings. Additionally, they can effectively cover gaps between teeth, enhancing both the appearance and functionality of your smile.

Cosmetic Tooth Contouring:

Referred to as tooth shaping or "enamel shaping," cosmetic tooth contouring is a procedure aimed at addressing minor issues such as chipping and slight tooth overlapping.


Cosmetic Orthodontic Treatment

Orthodontists specialize in straightening teeth and aligning bites, catering to both adults and children. Whether you're dealing with protruding teeth, crowding, gaps, or misalignment, consulting with your dentist can help determine if orthodontic treatment is suitable for you. Cosmetic Dental Veneers

A veneer, crafted from porcelain or composite material, is a delicate covering designed specifically for each tooth's front surface. It serves to address dental imperfections like minor misalignment, discoloration, or chipping, and can even bridge gaps between teeth.

While the longevity of a veneer varies among individuals, it typically endures for approximately 20 years. These veneers are fashioned from either thin porcelain or a resin-based composite material, each requiring a distinct procedural approach.
