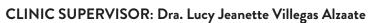

ORAL AND DENTAL CARE OF COMBAT-INDUCED PTSD

Many veterans have experienced and been diagnosed with Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

Combat studies validate with association stress experienced as an intense and traumatic event can increase the odds of orofacial morbidities that may affect oral, periodontal, or masticatory system health.

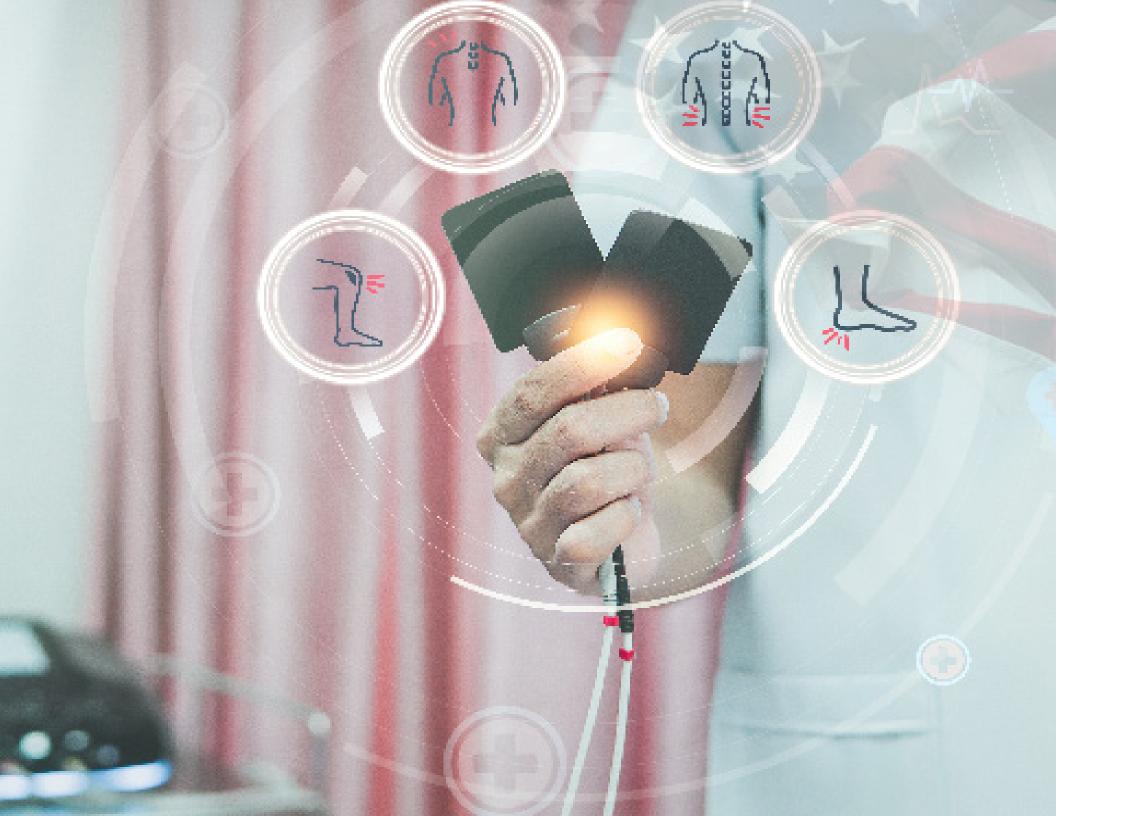
There have been many studies with PTSD patients where all patients suffered from periodontal disease, and most of them (66.0%) were severely affected. A significant correlation was found between signs of parafunctional activity and severe periodontal disease (high decayed, missing, and filled teeth). The doctors of the clinic have more than 20 years experiences connecting the association of Combat induced PTSD and oral and dental disabilities with Colombia military service members and police.

MENTAL HEALTH AND PSYCHOLOGY

There are three primary mental health concerns that you may encounter serving in the military.

- Postraumtic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Traumatic events, such as military combat, assault, disasters or sexual assault can have long-lasting negative effects such as trouble sleeping, anger, nightmares, being jumpy and alcohol and drug abuse. When these troubles don't go away, it could be PTSD. The 2014 JAMA Psychiatry study found the rate of PTSD to be 15 times higher than civilians.
- Depression. More than just experiencing sadness, depression doesn't mean you are weak, nor is it something that you can simply "just get over." Depression interferes with daily life and normal functioning and may require treatment. The 2014 JAMA Psychiatry study found the rate of depression to be five times higher than civilians.
- Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). A traumatic brain injury is usually the result of significant blow to the head or body. Symptoms can include headaches, fatigue or drowsiness, memory problems and mood changes and mood swings.





PHYSICAL THERAPY

Our physical therapists are focused to take care of patients in all phases of healing, from initial diagnosis to restorative and preventive stages of recovery. Physical therapy may be a standalone option, or it may support other treatments.

Our physical therapist will conduct a physical exam and evaluation of your movement, flexibility, muscle and joint motion, and performance, including finding out about your health history.

After a review of your medical clinical diagnosis a plan of care with short-term and long-term goals will be established including physical therapy treatment and intervention and self-management recommendations (exercises a person can do at home).

NEUROLOGY

Our Neurologist will provide treatment for sleeping disorders such as central sleep apnea, narcolepsy, insomnia, and restless legs syndrome.

Our team will diagnose or continue to treat your complex conditions through a physical examination and reviewing your detailed history (including testing of mental status, vision, speech, strength, sensation, coordination, reflexes, and gait). Even as medicine becomes more dependent on technology, the neurological exam will remain a critical component of the patient evaluation.

Our clinic also has access to subspecialty-trained neurologists who -also perform intraoperative brain and spine monitoring, autonomic testing, endovascular procedures including angiograms and coiling of aneurysms, botulinum toxin injections, skin and muscle biopsies.





SLEEP APNEA DENTAL MEDICINE

Sleep apnea not only impacts memory, but it can also lead to tangible damage to the brain by depriving it of oxygen.

Brain damage was accompanied by impairments to cognition, mood and daytime alertness. May shorten life span by 10 to 20 years.

Our veteran clinic is the first veteran clinic to manufacture the ORAL APPLIANCE for veterans overseas with this disability. This is specifically beneficial for veterans having trouble utilizing CPAP.

How do I participate: A veteran needs to register for the FOREIGN MEDICAL PROGRAM in order to participate in the Wellness Travel Program to receive physical therapy and psychotherapy. You have to VA disability of at least 0% to participate in the program. Dental service and Cell Regeneration is part of the program. We are the only clinic overseas that provides veterans with comprehensive dental care and cell generation.

Conditions may apply. You are responsible for travel, lodging, and food costs.

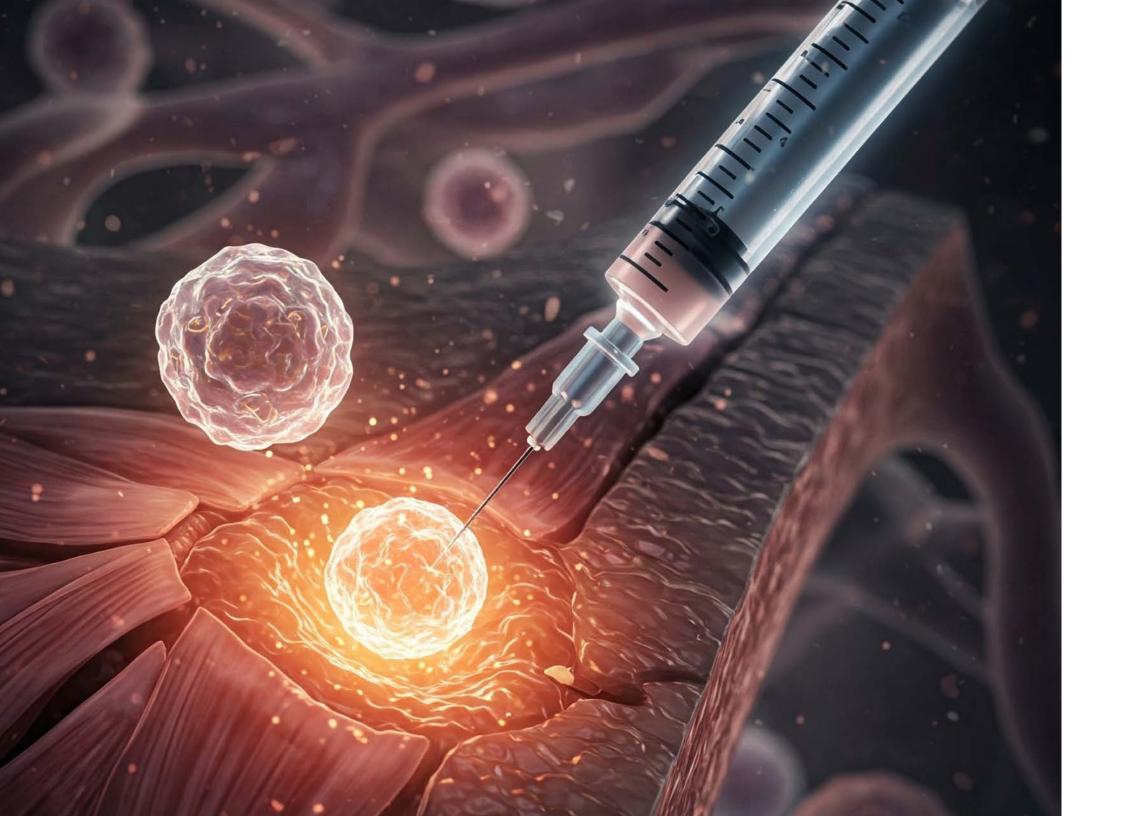

CELL REGENERATION

ORTHOPEDIC TRAUMA SURGEON WITH MORE THAN 20 YEARS EXPERIENCE will consult you if you are a good candidate. Secretary of Health of Colombia has strict regulations for the use of platelet-rich plasma and stem cell procedures. Colombia has some of the highest standards of medical care.

PLATELET-RICH PLASMA:

Platelet-rich plasma consists of two elements: plasma, or the liquid portion of blood, and platelets, a type of blood cell that plays an important role in healing throughout the body. Platelets are well-known for their clotting abilities, but thy also contain growth factors that can trigger cell reproduction and stimulate tissue regeneration or healing in the treated area.
