- SAT Preparation Course Instructor who drafted original SAT Reading and English tests de novo, designed curriculum, and taught cohorts of high-school students.
- Tutor Manager & Family Care Coordinator, recruiting and supervising other tutors, matching students with instructors, and acting as liaison for families.

He explains that he has always used teaching as a way to test his own understanding. That habit now benefits his students; he checks whether they can explain concepts back to him before moving on.

Website ready positioning:

Kevin blends a scientist's precision, a lawyer's clarity, and a teacher's patience. He has taught at the university level and has spent years working one on one with students to raise grades, boost scores, and rebuild confidence.

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### 4. Part C – Marketable Positioning and Testimonials

#### Core value propositions

From the combined reviews and profile, three core promises emerge that translate directly into website copy:

1. Clarity with difficult subjects
