Dear Parents & Families ...

As I sit down to write this year's recital letter, my heart feels especially full. There is something deeply emotional about reaching a milestone like this one ~ 35 years. Thirty-five years of music echoing through studio walls, giggles in the hallway, nervous backstage hugs, standing ovations, tears, triumphs, friendships, growth, and memories that somehow feel both fleeting and everlasting all at once. This year's recital showcase theme, "AIM Portrait: Framing 35 Years of Legacy," could not be more meaningful to me. A portrait is so much more than a photograph. It captures emotion, history, growth, personality, and love ~ all frozen into one frame. And when I look back across these 35 years, that is exactly what I see. I see a portrait painted with thousands of dancers, families, teachers, and moments that together have created something far bigger than I ever imagined possible.

I grew up dancing from age four, and honestly, dance saved me in more ways than I can even describe. It gave me confidence when I lacked it. It gave me purpose, discipline, identity, expression, belonging, and joy. It healed my heart when it was broken & it became the place where I felt understood. By the time I was in college, I realized dance could never simply remain part of my childhood ~ it had to become part of my adulthood and my life's work. That realization led me to Southern California to pursue a dance career, and when I returned home to Illinois two years later, Art In Motion was born.

At the time, I had no idea what God was truly beginning. Looking back now after 35 years, I can see so clearly how every step was paved long before I understood where the path was leading. Every challenge, every blessing, every open door, every person who entered this story ~ all of it became part of the masterpiece that AIM would eventually become, with God's grace. There were seasons when we soared with excitement and seasons when we simply held on tightly to faith.

What humbles me most is that AIM has become so much more than a dance studio. We strive for excellence. We work tirelessly to train, educate, inspire, and elevate our dancers to the highest levels possible. Every year, my AIM is to teach our students more ~ more technique, more artistry, more discipline, more passion, more understanding of what it means to truly work for something meaningful. I want them to leave here prepared not only for dance, but for life itself. But above all else, my greatest AIM has always remained the same... that every child who walks through our doors feels loved, accepted, valued, encouraged, safe, and adored. Long after recital costumes are packed away and the stage lights dim, what truly remains is how we made people feel.

One of the greatest blessings of my life has been watching AIM students grow into adults, parents, teachers, professionals, leaders, and incredible human beings. There are countless former students who still keep in touch with me regularly, and every single one feels like part of my extended family. To have been given the opportunity to sprinkle dance magic into their childhoods is an honor I could never properly put into words. And now, as we celebrate this 35th season, I look around and realize this portrait is continuously growing. Every dancer performing this weekend represents another brushstroke on the canvas of AIM's legacy. Every family has helped shape this story. Every teacher, every recital, every rehearsal, every late night, every encouraging word, every moment of belief ~ it all matters. This showcase is not simply a performance. It is a reflection of generations. A celebration of growth. A frame filled with memories, perseverance, joy, love, heartbreak, healing, laughter, artistry, and legacy. It is the portrait of an experience that has touched thousands of lives.

As you sit in the audience this weekend watching your children on stage, I hope you pause long enough to truly take it all in. Childhood moves unbelievably fast. One day they are nervously entering their very first dance class, and before you know it, they are taking their final bow. These moments are sacred. Hold onto them tightly. Watch their smiles & the sparkle in their eyes when they find you in the crowd... because what they are searching for most is not perfection. It is connection. It is pride. It is love.

Thank you for trusting us with your children. Thank you for believing in our vision. Thank you for helping build this extraordinary legacy over the past 35 years. As the curtain rises on this year's showcase, my hope is that when you look upon the stage, you do not simply see dancers performing within a frame... but rather a living portrait of 35 years of hearts, dreams, faith, family, and love ~ the beautiful legacy of AIM, forever framed in motion.
