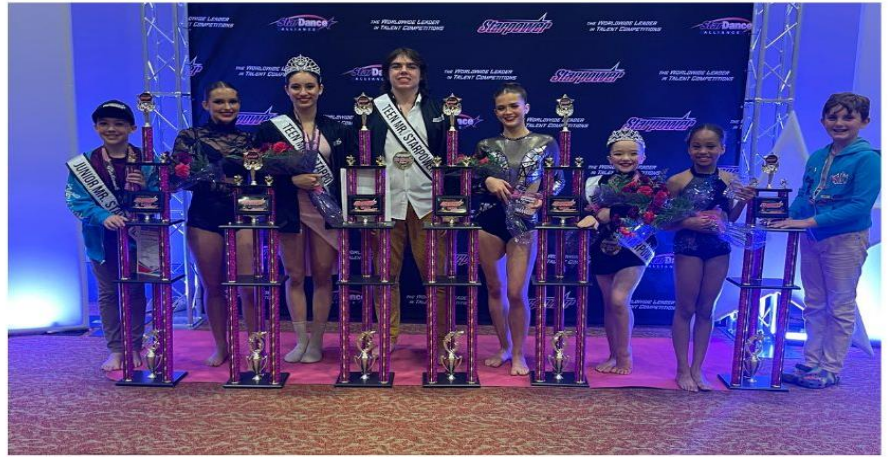


AIM COMPANY

The 2023-2024 competition company has had a very successful season! Dedication, sacrifice, drive, passion and unity are just a few words that describe the AIM Company. With 76 company dancers and 9 pre-company dancers ranging in age from 4-19, this company is a family of extraordinary humans! We have nine graduating seniors in the company this year! Last July, the company attended Starpower Nationals in Branson, MO. It was the most elite and advanced national competition of Starpower's summer events and we came home with AIMazing results! At the Battle of the Stars finals, we took home the senior victory cup (highest scoring senior dance) with "It Doesn't Hurt" choreographed by Skylee. In the battle, we also received 1st overall mini line, 1st overall teen large group, 1st overall teen line, 1st overall teen small group. Alyx Gardner received 1st runner up Senior Miss Starpower, Kash Farrell received Senior Mr. Starpower, Katharina Fleck received Teen Miss Starpower, Max Petersen received Teen Mr. Starpower, Aria Pape received Junior Miss Starpower and Owen Gough received 1st runner up Junior Mr. Starpower. We also received 1st overall junior duo/trio (Aria & Mallory) and 1st overall teen duo/trio (Kash & Sarah). We came home with several national champion awards in the advanced division. Congratulations to "Goodbye Yellow Brick Road" for winning the highest scoring mini group in the midwest region for the Star Dance Alliance & "Heal Our Land" for the highest scoring junior dance in our region! To kick off our 2023-2024 season, we traveled to Tribute National Talent Competition in Davenport, Iowa, followed by Adrenaline St. Louis, Radix Chicago, League of Champions Chicago, Starpower Chicago and Hall of Fame St. Louis. The dancers have soared at each and every event and won the highest score in the advanced division at Tribute with New York State of Mind, League of Champions with Just A Girl, and Starpower with Little Cloud, We Are The Truth, and Just A Girl. Our season will wrap up after we attend StarPower Nationals in Branson, MO this June. It takes a tremendous amount of time and dedication to be a part of this AIMazing company. We thank the parents for choosing to support & nurture these talents and we thank the dancers for growing into some of the strongest dancers and people we have ever had the privilege to teach.

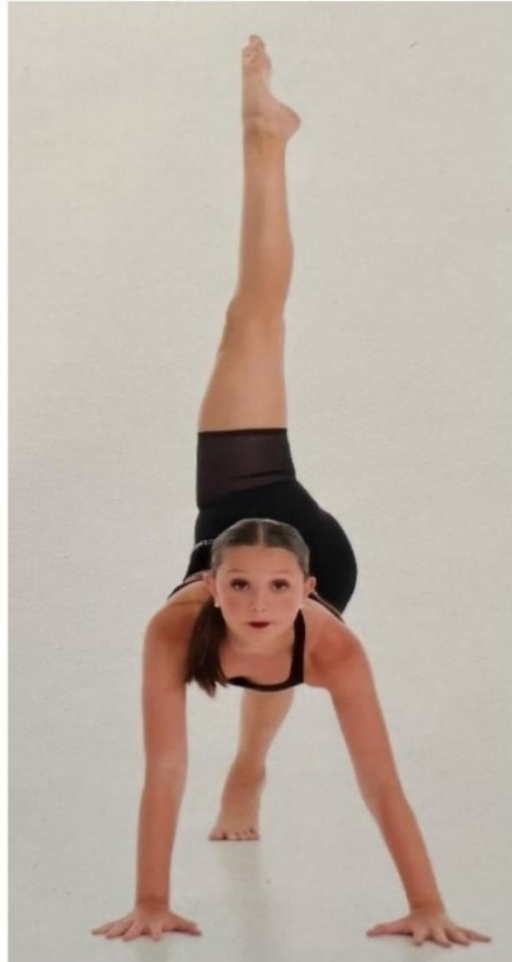

Chloe Jung

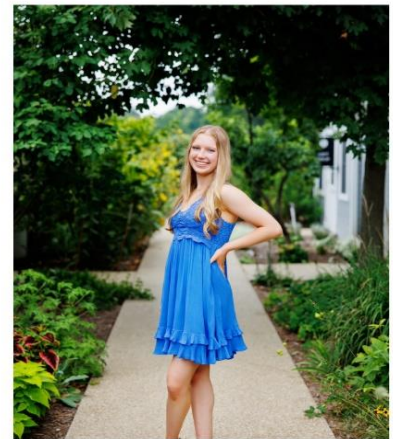

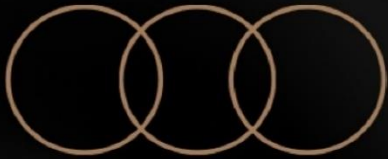
