Registration & Tuition

- **Registration Fee:** \$170 (non-refundable)
- **Tuition Options:**
 - 2.5's Class (Tues/Thurs AM): \$215/month
 - 3's Class (Tues/Thurs AM or PM): \$230/month
 - 4's Class (M/W/F AM or PM): \$270/month
 - 4/5's Class (5 days): \$330/month

Tuition is due between the 1st–10th of each month. Tuition is averaged across 10 months to ensure a consistent rate. No refunds are given for missed days due to holidays or vacations.

Please use the provided envelope each month to submit tuition, receive newsletters, and snack calendars. Make checks payable to **A Child's First Steps Preschool**. Cash receipts available upon request.

- 2.5's: Tues/Thurs 9:00–11:30 AM
 - 3's: Tues/Thurs 9:00–11:30 AM or 12:15–2:45 PM
 - 4's: M/W/F 9:00–11:30 AM or 12:15–2:45 PM
 - 4/5's: Combination of M/W/F and Tues/Thurs PM
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Arrival & Dismissal

Please arrive at the scheduled class time. Staff use the minutes before class to prepare. For safety, children must be escorted inside the building. At dismissal, please be patient as we safely release each child.

Late Pick-Up Policy: A 5-minute grace period is given. After that, a late fee of \$5 per minute will be billed.

Health & Safety

Keep your child home if they have a fever, rash, cough, vomiting, diarrhea, or symptoms of contagious illness. If your child becomes ill during school, we will call you and your emergency contacts.

Emergency drills for fire, earthquake, and lockdowns are practiced regularly. Please submit a family photo and comfort letter for use in emergency situations. If your child has severe allergies, provide necessary medical supplies (e.g., EpiPen).

Parent Involvement & Communication

We value your input! Please keep us informed of any major changes in your child's life. Monthly newsletters and calendars will keep you updated on events, themes, and snack schedules.

Curriculum Overview

Our age-appropriate curriculum includes:

- Language & literacy
- Math & science exploration
- Arts & crafts
- Music & movement

- Cultural awareness
- Cooking and nutrition
- Social/emotional development

We also teach responsibility, sharing, and self-help skills to prepare your child for kindergarten.

Show & Tell

Show and Tell promotes confidence and communication. One item per child, based on classroom themes, is encouraged.

- **4's:** Monday-Girls; Wednesday-Boys; Fridays-Teachers
 - **2's and 3's:** Tuesday-Girls; Thursday-Boys
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Field Trips

Field trips occur during regular hours and are accompanied by staff and parents. We expect one parent per child to be present. Transportation is provided by families. A signed Field Trip Consent and Liability Release form is required.

Snack & Nutrition

Children take turns providing snacks. A monthly snack calendar will indicate your child's day. Please bring enough for the whole class, including teachers. We strive to be a nut-free environment.

Examples: fruit, crackers, cheese, yogurt, muffins, veggies, popcorn, trail mix, granola

Birthday Snacks: Cupcakes and favorite treats are welcome! Children will also create a special birthday crown.

Discipline Policy

We use positive discipline strategies to guide behavior and teach self-regulation. Children are redirected and encouraged to make better choices. If ongoing issues arise, we will partner with families to support the child.

Diversity & Faith

We celebrate all cultures and welcome families to share their heritage. Children begin and end each day with prayer and sing a blessing before snacks. You are welcome to share a family prayer with us.

Potty Training

Children must be potty trained unless enrolled in the 2.5's class. For 2.5's, a signed Diaper Release form is required. If an accident occurs, we will contact an authorized adult to assist.

2025-2026

Because our tuition is based on actual operating expenses, we are unable to make refunds or adjustments on monthly tuition because of school holidays, family vacations, etc. Consideration will be given to those students who are absent because of lengthy illness. The Director and the Preschool Board will make all the decisions in these matters. Tuition is averaged over a 10-month period. Some months will have more classroom days than others. This way you are not being charged for holidays or Dieringer District school closures. The average results are simplified by having the same rate each month.

I have read and understand these terms regarding the 10 monthly payments due A Child's First Steps Preschool between the 1st and 10th of each month September through June unless prior arrangements have been made with the Director.
