Terrain:	The area is dominated by Pickpit Hill in the North of the map, which is situated amongst classic rolling Salisbury Plain countryside. The Southern part of the map is the backdoor trg area for 22 Engr and is a complete contrast with a mix of rough open areas a range of strip woods, some quite technical contour areas and paths.				
Mapping:	Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour. 5m contours LO, SG & Score at 1:7500, VSG at 1:5000 Full re-map in 2023 with further updates in 2024 and again for this event. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control descriptions for all courses on the map and also loose in the start lanes.
