Terrain:	Military training area, undulating terrain with sandy rough open, a mix of vegetation, good network of tracks and areas have good contour detail
Mapping:	Scale 1:7,500 5m contours, Map revised for this event. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions for all Line courses in the start lanes. No loose descriptions for the Relay. Control Descriptions also on the map.
MLS Prize Giving	This event is the MLS League Prize Giving event and the MLS Relay Champs. Prizes will be presented at 1200 hours and the Mass start Relay will start 10 minutes after Prize Giving is completed

All competitors must ensure they are fully hydrated before starting.

All runners must download by course closure time; even if you do not finish the course. Courses The MLS Relay Champs will have a mass start with 3 person teams racing at same time with a punching start. There will be a short brief and line up 10 minutes after Prize Giving is completed. The Relay legs are different from the line events. The winning team is the team with the fastest 3 completed leg times added together. 1 Long, 1 Medium & 1 Short

Team members should enter as individuals on the Long, Medium or Short Relay course with the same Team name which needs to be unique, ie BAOC Kickers. Ad Hoc team are most welcome to enter and take part. Full teams can start any time if duty requires, however, maps will be collected from early teams starting. And teams are not allowed to view line course maps before the Mass start.

Relay 1st Place prizes will be presented as soon as know on the day to the following categories.

- Open Men
- Open Women
- Vet Team, M/W 40 +
- Mil Vet Team M/W 55 +
- Ad Hoc Team

Second Run - Give the organiser an indication by email of what map you will have your 2nd run on, you will pay £1 EOD for the map, get a download, but will not appear on results.
