	Travel Directions: W3W: shifters.gurgled.revealing is the turn off the road leading from Janesmoor pond SE towards Ocknell Pond & Cadman's Pool car parks near where we had the start for MLS Slufts event on 14 Jan. clean.firebaseio.eating is for the actual entrance to the car park, which is concrete standing. Start is beside the car park, there is an 800m walk back from the finish to car park.			
	Terrain: This is another opportunity to run on an excellent New Forest map with a mixture of woods and open heathland which will again challenge your navigation skills. Switch off and you will soon be lost. All of the area is very runnable, so straight line running will be the order of the day, however note the wet areas, especially within the Bentley inclosures which are OOB so ensure you use marked crossing points. There is some heather, but the many small animal tracks also make this runnable, plus there is a good network of tracks.
