Terrain:	The event will be on the Bulford Camp map which includes the MQs area of Bulford and over to the Old Carter Bks square plus the western end of Bulford Ridge mainly open plain on a 70m high ridge running SW to NE A good network of tracks throughout. There is a road crossing in the Bulford Camp area.				
Mapping:	Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour for most courses with 1:7500 for Sh Green & 1:5000 for VSG. 5m contours, The Ridge was updated in 2024 with further updates for this event. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control descriptions for all courses on the map and loose in the start lanes.
