<b>Travel Directions:</b>	Event will be signed from the Staff College gate entrance off the A30 in Camberley at GU15 3EY. <b>What3words – odds.moped.reshaping</b> you will be checked off the entry list at the gate and will need photo ID for access and then follow signs.
<b>Terrain:</b>	You will mostly be running around buildings, a few lakes with some wood. The Academy grounds have a variety of tracks and incl some open grassy areas, but courses also venture amongst the very ornate buildings.
<b>Mapping:</b>	Minor updates for this event. 1:5,000 overprinted on A3/A4 waterproof paper. Control description on map and at the start.
