Terrain:		Tweseldown Equestrian Centre is mostly fast open terrain, with some mixed heathland and some complex hills in the middle. The courses all venture outside Tweseldown onto Trg Area B3, including Brock's Hill & Chestnut Copse which are both undulating mixed woodland areas with rough open intricate areas and a good network of tracks across a wide variety of terrain			
Mapping:		Scale 1:7500 (SG 1:5000, VSG 1:4000) overprinted on waterproof paper, Northern part of map, Brock's Hill area, completely updated in 2026. Many of the horse jumps within Tweseldown Race Course area are moved regularly, so only the static ones are now mapped. Loose CDs in start lane for all courses.
