Travel Directions:	W3W: fabricate.owners.appraised is the entry barrier to Ocknell campsite, Parking and arena are within the campsite area, follow signs to park on hard standing. Grid SU253120. There is then a 1.2km walk to the start and same back from finish. Clothing dump available at start/finish area.(There is an alternative option to drive closer and then walk in 500m)			
Terrain:	This is an opportunity to run on an excellent area not used for many years which will challenge your navigation skills. Switch off and you will soon be lost. Mixed undulating areas of mainly rough open/heathland with some small areas of forest inclosure, most of which is very runnable, so straight line running will be the order of the day, however note the stream through the inclosure is OOB so ensure you use the marked crossing points. There is also some heather, but the many small animal tracks also make this runnable, plus there is a good network of tracks.			
Mapping:	Minor updates for this event. Scale 1:10,000 for most, overprinted on waterproof paper. Loose control description will be provided at the start.
