

Risk Assessment Advice for School Visits

The following information will help you prepare a risk assessment for your school's visit to the Yorkshire Natural History Museum to ensure your visit runs as safely and smoothly as possible. If you have any further questions feel free to contact us via our email: info@ynhm.org.

- All our staff have undergone a basic disclosure (police check). Everyone is familiar with and complies with our Safeguarding Children and Adults at Risk Policy and Procedure.
- We have fully tested evacuation procedures in place in case of fire or other emergencies. In the case of an evacuation, our staff will escort school groups to a muster point.
- We have members of staff who are trained in first aid. Please inform our gallery staff immediately if anyone in your group requires assistance due to illness or injury.
- We have a written health and safety policy and all staff receive health and safety training.
- We have public liability insurance providing cover through Wilford Smith, as well as contents insurance from Circle Heritage in case of damage to the collections.
- Please inform our staff immediately if any pupils become separated from the group and you are unable to find them. We have procedures in place to deal with these situations.



GCSE Geology

We can provide lessons or workshops aimed at the WJEC Geology GCSE. Topics can include: minerals, the three major rock types, their deformation, the rock cycle, plate tectonics, global climate and sea level change, and of course fossils - and much more.



A Level Geology

Both OCR and WJEC syllabuses are covered. Topics include: minerals and rocks, Earth structure, plate tectonics, past life and climates, geohazards such as earthquakes, volcanoes and landslides, and natural resources. We also cover practical skills.

All our workshops and performances are designed and managed to remove or minimise hazards and we carry out a risk assessment for every activity. We check any materials, equipment or objects used to make sure they are safe and remove any trip/slip hazards. If a session involves a specific hazard that we feel teachers should know about, we will send this information to the school in advance of the visit and remind the group leader at the beginning of the activity.
