Finance Update

- o \$148000 \$26000 dues added
 - i. expenses included website hosting, awards, meeting costs, etc.
 - ii. How do we want to spend it? (will discuss in New Business)
- Minimum balance we would want to maintain to remain solvent (what amount?)

Membership Update

- Ontario Tech University newest member
- o 47 member institutions
- **Policy Updates** *Need to vote*
 - Listserv policy **APPROVED**
 - i. online conversations about issues (troubleshooting issues, etc.)
 - ii. new policy still allows for these online conversations
 - iii. amended language says informal requests and informal surveys can go out from member institutions
 - iv. move to approve seconded all in favor, none opposed (1 abstention)
 - Annual Survey Data Request Policy APPROVED
 - i. Most people check "only those requests specifically approved"
 - ii. Open for discussion no discussion
 - iii. Motion seconded and approved with none opposed (no abstentions)
 - ADPCCJ Bylaws (Updated) APPROVED
 - i. Degree granting program in CCJ
 - ii. Affiliate members looking to start a program / related degrees
 - 1. Not voting members
 - 2. Pay 75% of dues
 - 3. Students can get funded
 - iii. St. Leos (Florida) doctorate, not a PhD (primarily online) but they are accredited

1. Do not meet the bylaws definition for membership

- 2. 60 credit hours / no comps / no dissertation
- 3. Professional degree (not a research degree)
- 4. Membership votes that they do not meet the definition in the bylaws so no membership (unanimously approved)
- iv. Motion to approve changes to the bylaws
 - 1. Motion to approve changes to bylaws change the rule to not paying dues = not members
 - 2. Pay by the business meeting in November
 - 3. Motion passes unanimously with no abstentions

New Business

- Consider running for the executive board
 - Vice-President and Secretary/Treasurer will be up for election next year (November in Philadelphia)
- Planning for ACJS (unofficial meeting each March)
 - One hour discussion among member institutions suggestions for topics beyond those Natalie reviewed
 - Dealing with students post-Covid
 - Open hours for students funding questions
 - Natalie will distribute day and time of the meeting
- Retreat
 - Last one was in 2017 at Michigan State University
 - 1.5 days of programming
 - Hotel food meeting space –
- One rep per institution
 - Summit every other year?
 - o 2024 planning...
- Student Funding
 - Funding at a higher level approved at \$12,000 each fall/spring
- Should dues be lowered at this point?
 - Currently \$600/year
 - We basically bring in what we spend each year.
