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COURSE REQUIREMENTS

We are excited to have you join us for our Digital Media Academy courses! Each course, depending on which one you have registered for will have specific course requirements that need to be understood to get the most out of your learning experience. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Hardware

Laptop or desktop computer running updated Windows or Mac operating systems. Please review carefully the system requirements for each course, to ensure that the computer is suitable to participate.

Note: students are required to bring their own devices and accessories such as chargers, battery packs and peripherals such as mice and digital tablets. A very limited amount of computers may be able to be available for borrow but not guaranteed and subject to a first come first serve.

Software

Part of the course will be conducted using google Classroom as a main communication tool. It will be used to send and/or receive messages from the instructor and leave comments on student's work, post assignments and upload projects and exercises. Google Classroom is compatible with any updated browser, our recommendation is Google Chrome Browser.

Students shall receive a @digitalmediaacademy.org email account and a password that should be changed in the first 24 hours upon received. Please store this information safely and have it ready for the start of the course as it will be time consuming to reset the account settings in order to retrieve a new password and may affect the student's learning process. Use this email account to log in to the Google classroom.

Note: If the student does not have the required equipment and software for the respective course, they will not be able to participate in many of the activities and assignments.





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SCHEDULED TIMES

DMA Tech Summer Camps run from Monday July 4th to Friday July 29th. Every course has a different curriculum and different course requirements, although they start and end at the same hours. Breaks are shared between all of the courses to allow student integration and activities between classes.

Start time: 9:00 AM
Short Break 15': 10:45 AM
Lunch Break 1hr: 12:00 PM
Short Break 15': 2:45 PM
End time: 4:30 PM

Note: Students are to bring their own lunch and snacks for the camp. Lunch is **not** included on the fees for the courses and will not be available on location. If need to get any lunch or snacks for the rest of the day please ask staff to manage this by accompanying the student during the long break or whenever available. There are several options around for lunch, including the food court at Capilano Mall, approx. 250m from the location.

STUDENT SHOWCASE

On the last day of each week (Friday), a Student Showcase will be held where students will demonstrate what they have learned and their amazing work in a presentation style event where all parents/guardians are invited and encouraged to assist. A small ceremony will follow, in which Halfmoon Education will provide the students with a completion document. The event may vary in duration but should not run long. (max 30 min.) Please make arrangements to have parking and timing settled so you do not miss such event.

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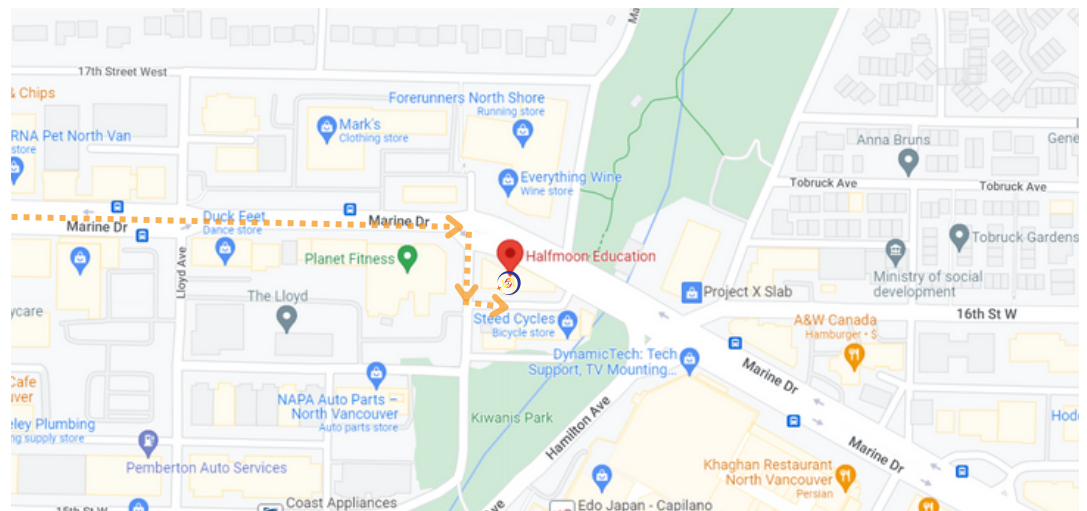
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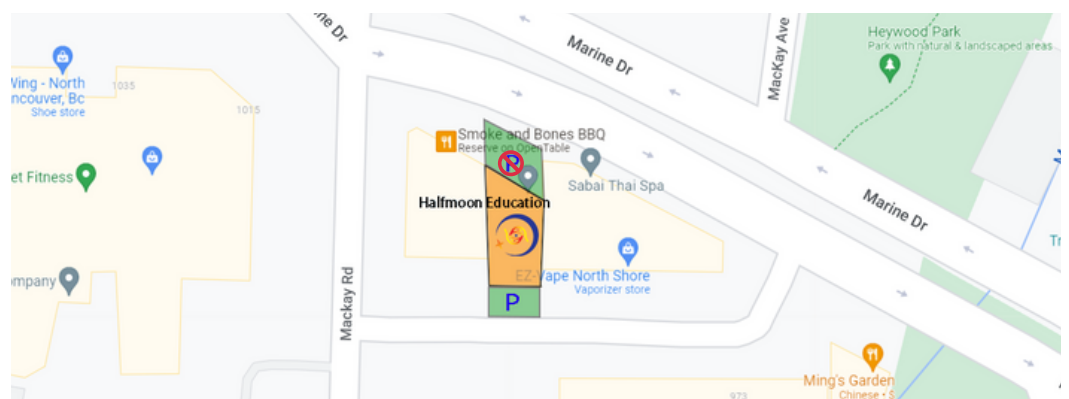
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LOCATION + PARKING

This year, we are hosting the courses at the Halfmoon Education North Vancouver location **991 Marine Drive V7P 1S4**. The easiest way to get there is to drive straight down Marine Drive and get to the **back** (no-stopping in the front) of the location for direct access to easy drop-in or pick-ups.



For parking, the back entrance is easily accessed by driving straight down Marine Drive and turning south on Mackay Road where you will be able to enter the parking lot. Exclusive parking for Halfmoon Education is limited and may be subject to first come first serve. There are many street parking available nearby. Note that other parking is at your own expense.



Additionally, if you are traveling by bus to Halfmoon Education, There are many lines that will drop you in Marine Dr. such as the **240, 241, 255, R2**. We recommend checking the local bus service website ahead of time before the start of the week.

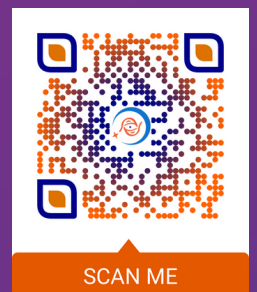
