Screen printing and digital printing each have their own strengths—and the better choice depends on what you're aiming for. Here's a breakdown of how they stack up:

Digital Printing (aka Direct-to-Garment or DTG)

Advantages:

- Detail & Color Complexity: Great for photorealistic images or designs with lots of colors and gradients.
- No Minimum Orders: Ideal for small batches or one-off prints.
- Faster Turnaround: Perfect for quick jobs—just load the file and go.
- Soft Feel: Because the ink soaks into the fabric, the print often feels smoother and lighter.

Considerations:

- Not as vibrant or durable on dark garments unless using pre-treatment.
- Ink can fade faster with repeated washing.

Screen Printing

Advantages:

- Vibrancy & Longevity: Inks sit on top of the fabric, which makes colors pop and last through many washes.
- Cost-Effective for Bulk Orders: Once the setup is done, printing multiple shirts is fast and affordable.
- Versatility on Materials: Works well not just on cotton, but also on synthetics, canvas, and more.
- Special Effects: Can use specialty inks like metallics, puff ink, glow-in-the-dark, etc.

Considerations:

- High setup cost for multiple colors—each color needs its own screen.
- · Less ideal for intricate, high-detail designs or low-quantity orders.
