What is a Family Meeting?

A family meeting is for you, your family and other people you are close to. The meeting helps you and your family come together to talk about problems and how they can help make things better.



I am your Social Worker

I will make the referral to FGDM and help you and your family to follow your plan

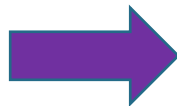


I am your Coordinator

I will help you to prepare for your meeting. We will talk about:
- What works well? - What would you like to change?
- Who could support you?

Stage 1

Social Worker & Coordinator will talk about why a family meeting could help you and help you to feel relaxed about the process



Stage 2

Private family time – the Social Worker and Coordinator will leave the meeting. You can have an advocate to help you share your views
