- JACC Website: Steve Gallagher noted that a website report is required every three years. The report has been completed, and the site now includes minutes from the past year and current financials.
- Jordan Mingle: Audua attended a meeting at the old Broadway clinic in Hawthorne to present JACC's harm reduction efforts. An informational session will be held January 13, 2025, from 10:30 AM to 5:30 PM at the new office. Partners will be present, and the session will include a Q&A.
- Syringe Exchange Program: JACC has been officially added as a syringe exchange site through the Minnesota Department of Health, effective December 1, 2025.
- Christmas Takeover: Innovative Solutions will provide gifts, and JACC will host the event. Gifts will be distributed to children, with Santa and the Grinch in attendance. The event will take place Wednesday, December 10, 2025, from 5:30 PM – 8:00 PM.
- Office Closure: The JACC office will be closed from December 11, 2025, through January 13, 2025. Staff (Aniya and Audua) will work in a hybrid capacity, accessing the office periodically during this time.
- Groceries Program: Grocery distribution has moved from Thursdays to Tuesdays. Kim has requested that Brothers Empowered continue grocery giveaways while the office is closed. JACC will continue renting trucks and supporting distribution, with Charles remaining involved.
- Fentanyl Free Communities Foundation: The organization reached out to JACC regarding the placement of a Narcan and fentanyl test strip dispenser outside the office. They would maintain inventory and restock as needed.
- Board Recruitment: Ongoing efforts to recruit new board members were discussed.
- JACC Christmas Gathering: A holiday gathering will be held Saturday, December 13, 2025, at 1:30 PM at Pinstripes.
