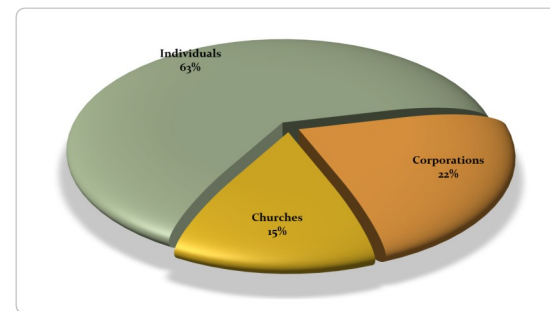

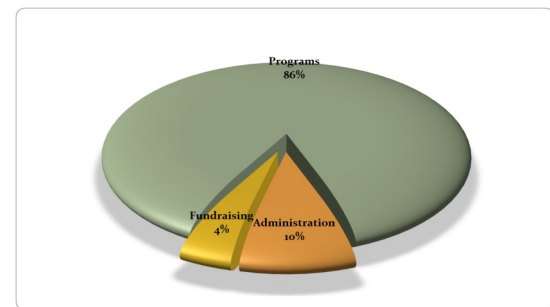


Who Supports TGRM?
