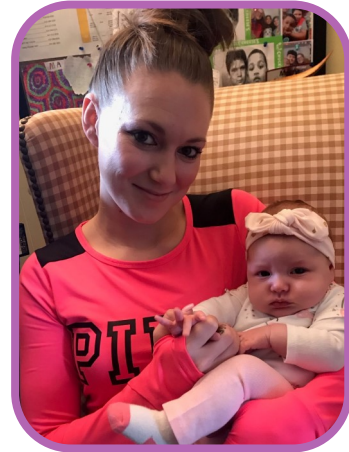
outwardly demonstrate in their lives. Colossians 3:12-14 Because of Jesus we can love and serve like he did...
