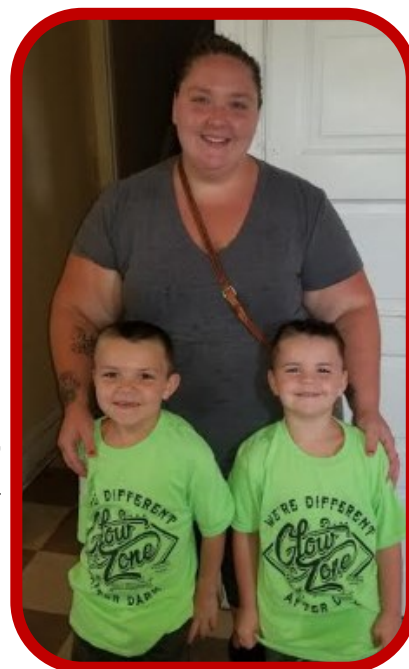
I would like to personally say "thank you" for everything that you have done and continue to
