



A Fighting Chance, Because Of You

Hello my name is Najlia A- Davis, I am a 21 year old single parent. My son and I came from Lansing Michigan/Flint Michigan. My sons name is King and he is 21 months old. When we left Michigan, my son had been diagnosed with lead poisoning from the water. We left soon after, during the water crisis.

When I came to Ohio, a counselor from another agency connected me to Rebekah's Haven. I didn't only leave because of my son being sick, I also left because I knew there was a slim chance of me getting my life together there. I wanted to make changes and be that role model for my son. I didn't want him to grow up in the same atmosphere. I wanted to be in a positive atmosphere so my son would have a chance in life. That's how I came to Rebekah's Haven.

Although even in a positive atmosphere with staff, chaplains and having chapel service, I took the influence of a negative lifestyle once again. I found myself following women that were leading me back to what I left behind. But, thanks to Mrs. Jacque for the second chance and believing in me, I am very blessed! I don't know where I'd be at today. Being here, my son and I are being taken care of and loved by a community of people. People who didn't even know us, just treating us with love & care, while I get myself together.

I am currently back in school! Due to Corona I am in an online school. Which is fine, because I'm still moving forward. Once I get my GED, I am going to go to college.

Honestly I thank God, the most high, for his mercy and grace. Being here at Rebekah's Haven has changed my life completely! As a child, I new about God, but not about

having a relationship with Him. I now have a relationship with Him. I also have a better understanding about how to go about life in general. I know and I feel I'm going through a real change. It makes me get so excited, and I want to stay close and connected to our Father who made it all possible.

I'm not without an everyday battle! During this Coronavirus, it has made that battle harder. I miss my family. I have not been able to go for a family visit. When I get stuck on those thoughts, I focus on the word of God. I know that He is in control and I cannot complain because He never fails me!
