Every day we are thankful for all that you do to help those we serve! It is truly a miracle to watch as you give time to volunteer, mentor, and minister! It is truly a blessing when you give food, clothing, and finances, so that through the ministries of TGRM people can be safe, warm, and find lasting peace! You are a blessing to us, and we appreciate you, but even more so THEY APPRECIATE YOU!

Moving forward to now, Toledo Gospel Rescue Mission is cautiously, and strategically reopening

to fully serve again! In the month of February, we saw Rebekah's Haven move into the new facility, the Outreach Center reopened for Tuesday Bible Studies, the Saturday Giveaways at the Mission Mall reopened by appointment, and the Men's Shelter was able to open under emergency procedures when the weather turned bad! TGRM hopes by Mid-April to fully reopen in each area as the safety protocols set by the Health Department allow! In the meantime, TGRM continues to be innovative and find ways to reach and serve those in need and know that however you can be a blessing through your time, talents, and treasure, that you are reaching those in their most desperate need with the light of Christ!
