**AUDIT SCOPE:**

Review of a conventional watermelon growing operation on 35 planted acres on a total of 40 acres of land known as the Parker Field. Last season the crop on this land was corn. Adjacent land is two residences, corn and woods. Typical growing season is from early-May to mid-September. This growing operation utilizes black plastic mulch and drip irrigation. Water for irrigation and for dilution of fertilizer and crop protection products is sourced from the Parker Field Well. One farm worker who was present during the audit was scouting.
