**AUDIT EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The scope of this audit is the growing area (Dodsia) and associated documentation of Pond-o-Gold, which produces conventional watermelons (cv. Fascination) on 70 acres of sandy soil. The typical rotation includes peanuts/corn/cotton in a 5-7 year sequence with one year of watermelons. Synthetic fertilizers and pesticides are applied. A well supplies water for pivot irrigation, pesticide mixing as well as hand wash water. A maximum of 4 employees are involved in production activities, which start in late March (plastic laying, planting) and end in July (harvest). No production activities were undergoing at the time of the audit. Portable toilets are supplied for the production workers. Adjacent land is composed of crops, roads, a pond and wooded areas.
