The Opening of Biohealth Hub @ Greencourt Innovation Center Celebrates Maryland's Growing Life Sciences and Biotechnologies Sector

Montgomery County, MD – October 18, 2024 – The opening of the Biohealth Hub @ Greencourt Innovation Center ("Biohealth Hub") was celebrated today with a special ceremony that brought together public officials, a diverse group of innovators, entrepreneurs, investors, community leaders, and stakeholders from Maryland's life sciences and biotechnologies community. The event marked a significant milestone with the Biohealth Hub set to play a central role in advancing biotechnology innovation, and breakthroughs and driving economic growth.



Co-founder Bei Ma delivered the opening remarks, expressing her excitement about the hub's launch and its mission to transform the life sciences landscape in the region. "It's an honor to welcome you all to the opening of the Biohealth Hub," said Ma. "Today's opening is a significant step in powering the next generation of entrepreneurs who will shape the future of medicine. At Biohealth Hub, our mission is clear: to provide unparalleled access to the key resources that drive success—capital, talent, and state-of-the-art lab space." She outlined the vision for the hub as the "easy button" for life sciences companies, facilitating seamless connections to funding, expertise, talent, and facilities to accelerate innovation.

Ma also reflected on the origins of the initiative, crediting Secretary of State Susan C. Lee, who, as then-Senator and State Senate Majority Whip, led the development of the policy proposal titled "Moving Maryland Forward as the Epicenter of Life Sciences and Biotechnology Innovation and Excellence." The proposal laid the foundation for the Biohealth Hub and a strategic approach to positioning Maryland as a global leader in life sciences and biotechnologies. Copies of the proposal were shared at the reception to provide attendees with insights into the foundational vision that guided the hub's creation.

Following Bei Ma's remarks, Secretary of State, Susan Lee, congratulated the Biohealth Hub in its launching at Greencourt Innovation Center, where co-founders Stephany Yu and Bei Ma hosted an inspiring evening of innovation, collaboration, and celebration in the life sciences community.

In her address, Secretary Lee highlighted the support from Governor Moore and the state government for this initiative and praised the Biohealth Hub for its role in fostering a new era of innovation in Maryland's biohealth sector. "The establishment of the Biohealth Hub marks a significant milestone in our state's journey to becoming a global leader in life sciences," said Secretary Lee. Secretary Lee highlighted the crucial role that life sciences and biotechnologies play in Maryland's economy and its growing reputation as a hub for scientific excellence. "Maryland's biohealth industry is not just a vital part of our economy, but also a source of breakthroughs that will improve lives around the world. This new Hub will create a center where startups, researchers, and established companies can work side by side to tackle some of the most pressing health challenges of our time," she continued. Secretary Lee concluded by expressing optimism about the future impact of the Biohealth Hub. "The journey of transforming ideas into lifechanging solutions requires not only expertise but also an ecosystem that nurtures creativity and accelerates growth. With the launch of the Biohealth Hub, we are taking a significant step towards cultivating the next wave of biotech innovations, right here in Maryland."





Maryland Montgomery County Executive, Marc Elrich, in his emphasized remarks, the strategic significance of the Biohealth Hub for the region's economic development and the advancement of public health. "Montgomery County has long been a leader in life sciences, and today, with the opening of the Biohealth Hub, we're adding another important piece to this sector," said Elrich. He further explained,

"with the National Institutes of Health, the Food and Drug Administration, and numerous biotech companies headquartered here, Montgomery County is already at the forefront of biomedical research and innovation. State Senator Clarence Lam, the only physician serving in the Maryland State Senate, delivered an inspiring speech at the opening of the Biohealth Hub, underscoring the significance of the new center for advancing healthcare innovations in Maryland. Representing the Maryland General Assembly, he also presented a special citation to co-founders Stephany Yu and Bei Ma, recognizing their contributions to the state's biohealth sector.

"We are living in a time of rapid change in medicine, from personalized therapies to advanced diagnostics," continued Lam. "The Biohealth Hub will play a pivotal role in accelerating the translation of scientific discoveries into real-world solutions, ensuring that patients benefit from the latest advances in medical science."





As a representative of the Maryland General Assembly, Senator Lam presented a citation to co-founders Stephany Yu and Bei Ma, formally acknowledging their achievements and the positive impact of their work on the state's life sciences industry. "It is with great pride that I present this citation on behalf of the General Assembly to recognize your outstanding contributions to Maryland's life sciences and biohealth ecosystem," he said, as he handed the framed citation to Ma and Yu. "Your leadership in establishing the Biohealth Hub @ Greencourt Innovation Center will leave a lasting legacy, not only in advancing the biohealth industry but also in improving the quality of life for Marylanders."

Co-founder, Stephany Yu also addressed the audience, emphasizing the importance of the hub's collaborative approach. "We are building a unique center dedicated supporting to facilitating meaningful entrepreneurs by partnerships across the public, private, and academic sectors," said Yu.
