

21 April 2026: UPS - Surge Emergency Fee Update effective 19th April, 2026

Effective April 19, 2026, and subject to change at UPS's discretion, a Surge Emergency Fee (previously referred to as the Surge Fee) will apply to all import and export shipments between selected origin and destination pairs. Please refer to the UPS shipping costs and rates page for the latest updates on the Surge Emergency Fee.

This fee will be subject to applicable fuel surcharge and calculated based on the billable weight of each shipment.

The Surge Emergency Fee is a temporary pricing measure introduced to support ongoing operational adjustments required to maintain service continuity and reliability in response to evolving market conditions.

Please note that Surge Emergency Fees are subject to change. Shippers are encouraged to regularly visit the UPS shipping costs and rates page for the latest Surge Emergency Fee rates prior to tendering shipments.
