## WISH LIST

The Lezama Family Happy Tails Dog Park, managed by the Happy Tails Dog Park of the Lakes Region, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, gladly accepts donations for our dog park!

This list ranges from fairly small expenses to some large ones. We would need to have the City of Laconia approve any additions to the park, so the easiest way to proceed with a donation for a specific item is to let us know, and we'll seek approval. Once approved, we can receive your donation and move forward.

Cash donations will go into our general fund, which could be used for regular operating expenses or towards one of our other needs – Unless explicitly stated.

- Drainage repair in the large dog pen: Water collects at the bottom of the hill, creating a large puddle that
  creates health and hazardous issues for the dogs and their families (this can be a cash donation or onsite
  job donation).
- Sponsorship for park-related merchandise: T-shirts, hoodies, hats, magnets, stickers with your business logo on the back of clothing items and recognition on our website and social media.
- Small shade structure in puppy pen: The larger pens have trees that provide shade, but there is no shade in the puppy pen. We used a canopy last year, but it did not weather well, so a durable sunscreen (no sides) would be appreciated. <a href="http://awningsnh.com/sail-shades/">http://awningsnh.com/sail-shades/</a>
- Small shed for supply storage: Onsite space to store trash bags, rakes, shovels, etc.
- Donation box and installation: To be able to safely take cash donations at the park.
- Video security camera: One or more so we can monitor the park when necessary. The one we're looking at is inexpensive, solar (since we have no power), records in a loop, and can be viewed over a cell phone app.
- Agility equipment: We currently have large boulders for the dogs to climb on, which they love, but we would be interested in more equipment for the dogs.
- Covered/waterproof flyer/bulletin box/board: For incident reports, flyers, or brochures.
- Partition shade for center fencing: Place on the fence between the small and large dog pens to block the vision of the dogs on either side to keep excitement level down. Could also be placed on front fences in the small and large pens so dogs will not bark and head for the entrance when they see a car pull up.
- Sponsorship for special fundraiser events at park: Periodically we'd like to have some special events with
  refreshments and merchandise to raffle and hand out. Dedicated events, like a Halloween costume party,
  etc., could be planned.
- Connection to city water line: There is no water currently except what people bring in, but there is a city water line in the cul-de-sac of Growtth Road (this can be a cash donation or onsite job donation).
- Artificial turf: Provides a softer surface and can be hosed down easily (need connection to city water first), durable for 15-20 yrs., such as K-9 Artificial turf.

If you are a contractor or a handy-person, we would be grateful to receive donations in the form of labor or materials - or a combination of both.
