# Day Six.

So now we have learned from scriptures what was done from day 1 to day 6. 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Now, If we go to <u>Genesis 2<sup>nd</sup> Chapter</u>, we will see what <u>may appears</u> to be one of two makings of Man; or possibly the original making of a male and female that would resemble in ways a Man and Woman.

# Genesis 2 Authorized (King James) Version

1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. <sup>2</sup> And on the seventh day Yah ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. <sup>3</sup> And Yah blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which Yah created and made.

Okay, this is a lot of information to process, but did you notice any differences in the male and female in Genesis Chapter 1 and what happened in Genesis Chapter 2?

# Genesis Chapter 1

- 1. At verse 27 both <u>male</u> and <u>female</u> were created in the same day.
- 2. They were created as an image (Certain similarities, but **NOT** the same) of Yah
- 3. The male and female were created on the **sixth day**
- 4. There is no mention of the created male and female being in the Garden of Eden.

## Genesis Chapter 2

- 1. Verse 1 the Heavens and Earth were finished
- 2. It was the seventh day and Yah blessed and sanctified it
- 3. Yah finished, completed [Put the polishing touches on all that He created] at the beginning of the **seventh day**, and then rested from all the work that He had done.
- 4. There was no man yet in the seventh day
- 5. Verse 7 Yah FORMED Man, Yah breathed into the Man's nostrils THEN he became a living Soul
- **6.** Verse 8 Yah planted the Garden of Eden
- 7. Verse 9 there is a tree of life, and a tree containing the knowledge of good and evil, in the middle of the garden [Satan, Lucifer]
- **8.** Verse 10 the Garden contains 4 rivers
- 9. Verse 18 & 20 Adam was alone in the Garden of Eden and there was no help meet [Woman] for him, and it was still the seventh day
- **10.** Verse 21 Adam undergoes surgery for Yah to take one of his ribs Verse 22 to make a woman
- 11. The Man and Woman were sanctified in/during the seventh/ Sabbath day, so one could look at this as an example that the Creator Yah will ONCE again live on Earth [Zechariah 1:16, 8:3] within the restored Garden of Eden with the descendants of Adam and Eve that are currently called the Children of Israel.

Genetically Modified Organisms (GMO)

# A genetically modified organism (GMO) is any organism whose genetic material has been altered using genetic

engineering techniques. The exact definition of a genetically modified organism and what constitutes genetic engineering varies, with the most common being an organism altered in a way that "does not occur naturally by mating and/or natural recombination". A wide variety of organisms have been genetically modified (GM), from animals to plants and microorganisms. Genes have been transferred within the same species, across species (creating transgenic organisms) and even across kingdoms. New genes can be introduced, or endogenous genes can be enhanced, altered or knocked out.

Creating a genetically modified organism is a multi-step process. Genetic engineers must isolate the gene they wish to insert into the host organism and combine it with other genetic elements, including a <u>promoter</u> and <u>terminator</u> region and often a <u>selectable marker</u>. A number of techniques are available for <u>inserting the isolated gene into the host genome</u>. Recent advancements using <u>genome editing</u> techniques, notably <u>CRISPR</u>, have made the production of GMO's much simpler. <u>Herbert Boyer</u> and <u>Stanley Cohen</u> made the first genetically modified organism in 1973, a bacteria resistant to the antibiotic <u>kanamycin</u>. The first genetically modified

<u>animal</u>, a mouse, was created in 1974 by <u>Rudolf Jaenisch</u>, and the first plant was produced in 1983. In 1994 the <u>Flavr Savr</u> tomato was released, the first commercialized <u>genetically modified</u> <u>food</u>. The first genetically modified animal to be commercialized was the <u>GloFish</u> (2003) and the first genetically modified animal to be approved for food use was the <u>AquAdvantage salmon</u> in 2015.

<u>Bacteria are the easiest organisms to engineer</u> and have been used for research, food production, industrial protein purification (including drugs), agriculture, and art. There is potential to use them for environmental, purposes or as medicine. Fungi have been engineered with much the same goals. Viruses play an important role as <u>vectors</u> for inserting genetic information into other organisms. This use is especially relevant to human <u>genetherapy</u>. There are proposals to remove the <u>virulent</u> genes from viruses to create vaccines.

Plants have been engineered for scientific research, to create new colors in plants, deliver vaccines and to create enhanced crops. Genetically modified crops are publicly the most controversial GMOs. The majority are engineered for herbicide tolerance or insect resistance. Golden rice has been engineered with three genes that increase its nutritional value. Other prospects for GM crops are as bioreactors for the production of biopharmaceuticals, biofuels or medicines.

Animals are generally much harder to transform and the vast majority are still at the research stage. Mammals are the best <u>model organisms</u> for humans, making ones genetically engineered to resemble serious human diseases important to the discovery and development of treatments. Human proteins expressed in mammals are more likely to be similar to their natural counterparts than those expressed in plants or microorganisms.

Livestock are modified with the <u>intention of improving economically important traits</u> such as growth-rate, quality of meat, milk composition, disease resistance and survival. <u>Genetically modified fish</u> are used for scientific research, as pets and as a food source. <u>Genetic engineering has been proposed as a way to control mosquitos</u>, a <u>vector</u> for many deadly diseases. Although human gene therapy is still relatively new, it has been used to treat <u>genetic disorders</u> such as <u>severe combined immunodeficiency</u>, and <u>Leber's congenital amaurosis</u>.

Many objections have been raised over the development of GMO's, particularly their commercialization. Many of these involve GM crops and whether food produced from them is safe and what impact growing them will have on the environment. Other concerns are the objectivity and rigor of regulatory authorities, contamination of non-genetically modified food, control of the <u>food supply</u>, <u>patenting of life</u> and the use of <u>intellectual property</u> rights. Although there is a <u>scientific consensus</u> that currently available food derived from GM crops poses no greater risk to human health than conventional food, GM food safety is a leading issue with critics. <u>Gene flow</u>, impact on non-target organisms and escape are the major environmental concerns. Countries have adopted regulatory measures to deal with these concerns.

There are differences in the regulation for the release of GMOs between countries, with some of the most marked differences occurring between the US and Europe. Key issues concerning regulators include whether GM food should be labeled and the status of gene edited organisms.

And there shall you build an **altar** unto Yah your God, an **altar** of stones: you shall not lift up any iron **tool** upon them.

#### **CEB**

But if you do make for me an altar from stones, don't build it with chiseled stone since using your chisel on the stone will make it impure.

#### **DARBY**

And if you make me an altar of stone, you shalt not build it of hewn/cut stone; for if you lift up your sharp tool upon it, you have profaned it.

#### **ERV**

But if you use stones to make an altar, then don't use stones that were cut with an iron tool. If you do that, it will make the altar unacceptable.

#### **EXB**

If you use stones to make an altar for me, don't use ·stones that you have shaped with tools [hewn/cut stones]. When you use any ·tools [chisel] on them, you ·make them unsuitable for use in worship [profane them].

#### GW

If you build an altar for me made out of stones, never make it with cut stone blocks. If you use a chisel on it, you will make it unacceptable to me.

#### **ICB**

You may use stones to make an altar for me. But don't use stones that you have made smooth with tools. You must not use any tools on the stones. If you do, you make them unsuitable for use in worship.

## TLB

You may also build altars from stone, but if you do, then use only uncut stones and boulders. Don't chip or shape the stones with a tool, for that would make them unfit for my altar.

#### NOG

If you build an altar for me made out of stones, never make it with cut stone blocks. If you use a chisel on it, you will make it unacceptable to me.

#### **NABRE**

But if you make an altar of stone for me, do not build it of cut stone, for by putting a chisel to it you profane it.

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

#### **NIRV**

If you make an altar out of stones to honor me, do not build it with blocks of stone. You will make it "unclean" if you use a tool on it.

But if you *decide to* build an altar out of stones for Me, use *only natural stones*, not hand-cut stones, because any attempt to shape them with your tools will desecrate the altar.

## **WYC**

That if you shall make an altar of stone to me, you shall not build it of stones hewn (And if you make an altar out of stones for me, you shall not build it out of cut stones); for if you shall raise your knife thereupon, or (any) other instrument wherewith blood [A sacrifice] may be shed out, [sacrificed on it] it shall be polluted.

[Earthen, - means - Made out of the dust of the ground like Man was] Sacrifice your Whole-Burnt-Offerings, [Burnt Offering is A Sin Offering] your Peace-Offerings, your sheep, and your cattle on it. Every place where I cause my name to be honored in your worship, I'll be there myself and bless you.

If you use stones to make my Altar, don't use dressed stones. If you use a chisel on the stones you'll profane the Altar. Don't use steps to climb to my Altar because that will expose your nakedness."
[Nakedness means your genitals, - sexual body parts]

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>24</sup> Take earth and build an altar to Me and sacrifice all of your burnt offerings and peace offerings there. Offer Me *the best of* your sheep and oxen. Wherever I choose for My name to be remembered, I will come to you and shower blessings upon you.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>25</sup> But if you *decide to* build an altar out of stones for Me, use *only natural stones*, not hand-cut stones, because any attempt to shape them with your tools will desecrate the altar. <sup>26</sup> Also, do not approach My altar by walking up steps, for *you might profane the altar by* exposing your nakedness." [What is *viewable under your clothing/robes*]

#### <u>Leviticus 19:19</u> King James Version

Ye shall keep my statutes. You shall not let your cattle **gender** with a diverse kind: you shall not sow your field with mingled seed: neither shall a garment mingled of linen and wool come upon you.

## Other translations

#### **AMP**

You are to keep My statutes. You shall not breed together two kinds of your cattle; you shall not sow your field with two kinds of seed, nor wear clothing of two kinds of material mixed together.

You shall keep My statutes. You shall not let your domestic animals breed with a different kind [of animal]; you shall not sow your field with mixed seed, neither wear a garment of linen mixed with wool.

"You are to keep my statutes. Do not crossbreed two different kinds of your livestock, sow your fields with two kinds of seed, or put on a garment made of two kinds of material.

You must keep my rules. Do not crossbreed your livestock, do not plant your field with two kinds of seed, and do not wear clothes made from two kinds of material.

#### CJB

"'Observe my regulations. "'Don't let your livestock mate with those of another kind, don't sow your field with two different kinds of grain, and don't wear a garment of cloth made with two different kinds of thread.

#### **CEV**

Breed your livestock animals only with animals of the same kind, and don't plant two kinds of seed in the same field or wear clothes made of different kinds of material.

#### **EXB**

"'·Obey [Keep; Guard] my ·laws [Lattutes; ordinances; requirements]. You must not ·mate [breed] two different kinds of ·cattle [animals] or sow your field with two different kinds of seed. You must not wear clothing made from two different kinds of material mixed together.

The context seems to favor the former. Put and Lud were in North Africa; Meshech, Rosh, and Tubal were in Asia Minor and Armenia.
- 2. <u>Isaiah 66:20</u> *transporting them gently,* implied.

And you shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an **holy nation**. These are the words which you shall speak unto the children of Israel.

## The Folly of Idolatry

- <sup>9</sup> All who make carved idols are nothing. Their precious objects are worthless [to them], and their own witnesses (worshipers) fail to see or know, so that they will be put to shame. <sup>10</sup> Who has made a god or cast an idol which is profitable for nothing?
- <sup>11</sup> In fact, all his companions will be put to shame, for the craftsmen themselves are mere men. Let them all assemble, let them stand up, let them be terrified, let them together be put to shame.
- <sup>12</sup> The ironsmith shapes iron *and* uses a chisel and works it over the coals. He forms the [idol's] core with hammers and works it with his strong arm. He also becomes hungry and his strength fails; he drinks no water and grows tired.

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

<sup>15</sup> Then it becomes *fuel* for a man to burn, so he takes one of them and warms himself; he also kindles a fire to bake bread. He also makes a god [from the same wood] and worships it. He makes it into a carved idol [with his own hands] and falls down and worships it!

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>22</sup> Then Yahweh said, "Now that the man has become as we are, **knowing good from bad**, what if he eats the fruit of the Tree of Life and lives forever?" <sup>23</sup> So Yahweh banished him forever [*Forever in this context means for a very long time*] from the Garden of Eden, and sent him out to farm the ground from which he had been taken. <sup>24</sup> Thus Yah expelled him, and placed mighty angels at the east of the Garden of Eden, with a flaming sword to guard the entrance to the Tree of Life.

No enigmas/mysteries can stump you.
Your sharp intelligence
made you world-wealthy.
You piled up gold and silver
in your banks.
You used your head well,
worked good deals, made a lot of money.
But the money has gone to your head,
swelled your head—what a big [Proud] head!

<sup>6-11</sup> "Therefore, YAH, the Master, says:

"Because you're acting like a god, pretending to *be* a god,

They'll pull their swords and make hash of your reputation for knowing it all.

They'll puncture the balloon of your god-pretensions.

They'll bring you down from your self-made pedestal and bury you in the deep blue sea.

You were dressed in splendor, your robe studded with jewels: Carnelian, peridot, and moonstone, beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald, all in settings of engraved gold.

#### Ezekiel 10:6-8 Ezekiel 1st Chapter wheel within wheel

When Yah commanded the man <u>dressed in linen</u>, "Take <u>fire</u> from among <u>the wheels</u>, from between the cherubim (Angels)," he went in and stood beside a wheel. One of the cherubim (Angels) reached into <u>the fire</u>, took some <u>coals</u>, and put them <u>in the hands of the man dressed in linen</u> [Ezekiel 9<sup>th</sup> Chapter a man <u>dressed in linen</u> with the inkwell by his side]. He took them and went out. Something that looked like a human hand could be seen under the <u>wings</u> (Isaiah 6<sup>th</sup> Chapter) of the cherubim.

# From the day of your creation

you were sheer perfection...

<sup>25-26</sup> YAH, the Master, says, "When I gather Israel from the peoples/nations among whom they've been scattered and put my holiness on display among them with all the nations looking on, then they'll live in their own land that I gave to my servant Jacob. They'll live there in safety. They'll build houses. They'll plant vineyards, living in safety. Meanwhile, I'll bring judgment/punishment on all the neighbors who have treated them with such contempt. And they'll realize that I am YAH."

# (2) Who were the warring parties?

It was Yahweh, and the Angels who sided against, Yahweh and joined Lucifer, the Covering Cherubim Angel and those of the Angels he convinced to go against Yah.

These would be the fallen Angels and the offspring/children born of the sexual union of the fallen Angels and women on earth. The descendants of these would, (In the **End-time**) try to fight and overcome the Ancient of Days!

In the Greek Book it is also recognized:

#### Revelation 12:4

His tail swept a third of the stars **out** of ·the sky [or **heaven**] and ·threw [**cast**; hurled; Dan. 8:10] them down to the earth [<sup>C</sup> representing an early victory against Yah's people; 12:1].

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

He stood in front of the woman who was ready to give birth so he could ·eat [devour] her ·baby [child; [the Messiah, - meaning the Anointed of Yah; Psalms 2<sup>nd</sup> and 110<sup>th</sup> Chapters, 2 Samuel 7<sup>th</sup> Chapter] as soon as it was born/ID.

#### • Revelation 12:9

The ·giant [great] dragon was ·thrown down [cast; hurled] out of heaven. (He is that ·old snake [ancient serpent] called the devil or Satan [Gen. 3:1, 15], who ·tricks [deceives; leads astray] the whole world.)
The dragon with his angels was ·thrown down [cast; hurled] to the earth.

#### There was a war in heaven!

#### Numbers 24:14 Balaam the Prophet and Balack the King Moabites

And now, behold, I go unto my people: come therefore, and I will advertise you what this people shall do to your people in the **latter days**.

When Balaam saw that it pleased Yahweh to bless Israel, he did not go as he had done each time before [superstitiously] to meet with omens *and* signs in the natural world, but he set his face toward the wilderness *or* desert.

- <sup>2</sup> And Balaam lifted up his eyes and he saw Israel abiding/living in their tents according to their tribes. And the Spirit of Yah came upon him
- <sup>3</sup> And he took up his [figurative] discourse and said: Balaam son of Beor, the man whose eye is opened [at last, to see clearly the purposes and will of Yah],
- <sup>4</sup> He [Balaam] who hears the words of Yah, who <u>sees the vision</u> of the Almighty, falling down, but having his eyes [*WIDE*] open *and* uncovered, he says:
- <sup>5</sup> How attractive and considerable are your tents, O Jacob, and your tabernacles, O Israel!
- <sup>6</sup> As valleys are they spread forth, as gardens by the riverside, as [rare spice] of lignaloes which Yahweh has planted, and as cedar trees beside the waters.
- <sup>7</sup> [Israel] shall pour water out of his own buckets [have his own sources of rich blessing and plenty], and his offspring/children shall dwell/live by many waters, and his king shall be higher than <sup>[a]</sup>Agag, and his kingdom shall be exalted.
- <sup>8</sup> Yah brought [Israel] forth out of Egypt; [Israel] has strength like the wild ox; he shall eat up the nations, his enemies, crushing their bones and piercing them through with his arrows.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>9</sup> He couched, he lay down as a lion; and as a lioness, who shall rouse him? Blessed [of Yah] is he who blesses you [who prays for and contributes to your welfare] and cursed [of Yah] is he who curses you [who in word, thought, or deed would bring harm upon you].

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>14</sup> And now, behold, I am going to my people; come, I will tell you what this people [Israel] will do to your people [Moab] in the <u>latter days</u>.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>16</sup> He speaks, who heard the words of Yah and knew the knowledge of the Most High, who saw the vision of the Almighty, falling down, but having his eyes wide/open *and* uncovered:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>17</sup> <u>I see Him</u>, <u>but not now</u>; I behold Him, <u>but He is not near</u>. A <sup>[b]</sup>star (Star) shall come forth out of Jacob, and a scepter (Scepter) shall rise out of Israel and shall crush all the corners of Moab and break down all the sons of Sheth [Moab's sons of tumult]. (*Look at Genesis 49<sup>th</sup> Chapter*)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>18</sup> And Edom shall be [taken as] a possession, [Mount] Seir also shall be dispossessed, who were Israel's enemies, while Israel does valiantly.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>19</sup> Out of Jacob shall one (One) come having dominion and shall destroy the remnant from the city.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>20</sup> [Balaam] looked at Amalek and took up his [prophetic] utterance, and said: Amalek is the foremost of the [neighboring] nations, **but in his latter end he shall** [c] **come to destruction**.

#### Other versions

#### **KJ21**

And it waxed great, even to the host of heaven; and it cast down some of the host and some of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them.

#### **ASV**

And it waxed great, even to the host of heaven; and some of the host and of the stars it cast down to the ground, and trampled upon them.

#### **AMPC**

And [in my vision this horn] grew great, even against the host of heaven [Yah's true people, the saints], and some of the host and of the stars [priests] it cast down to the ground and trampled on them,

It grew as high as the heavenly army, made some of the army and some of the stars fall to the earth, and trampled them.

#### **CEB**

It grew as high as the heavenly forces, until it finally threw some of them and some of the stars down to the earth. Then it trampled on them.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>23</sup> And he took up his [prophetic] speech, and said: Alas, who shall live when Yah does this *and* establishes [Assyria]?

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>24</sup> But ships shall come from Kittim [Cyprus and the greater part of the Mediterranean's east coast] and shall afflict Assyria and Eber [the Hebrews, certain Arabs, and descendants of Nahor], and he [the victor] also shall come to destruction.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>25</sup> And Balaam rose up, returned to his place, and Balak also went his way.

It exalted itself against the army of heaven. It made some of that army and some of the stars fall to earth, and it trampled them.

#### **EXB**

That ·little horn [Lit] grew ·until it reached to the sky [Lto the hosts of heaven; Cthe angels and the stars]. It even threw some of the ·army of heaven [Lhosts and the stars] to the ground and ·walked on [trampled] them!

#### **ICB**

That little horn grew until it reached to the sky. It even threw some of the army of heaven to the ground. And it walked on them.

# **Daniel 8 Expanded Bible**

Daniel's Vision

During [In] the third year of King Belshazzar's rule [C perhaps 547 BC], I, Daniel, saw another vision, which was like the first one [L after the one that appeared to me in the beginning/previously; 7:1]. In this vision I saw myself in the capital city [or fortress city] of Susa, in the carea [province] of Elam. (Babylon) I was standing by the Ulai ·Canal [or Gate]

- <sup>3</sup> when I ·looked up and [<sup>L</sup> lifted my eyes I] saw a ·male sheep [ram] standing beside the ·canal [or gate]. It had two long horns, but one horn was longer and ·newer than the other [<sup>L</sup> came up second].
- <sup>4</sup> I watched the ·sheep [ram] charge to the west, the north, and the south. No animal could stand before him, and none could ·save [protect] another animal from his ·power [L hand]. He did whatever he ·wanted [pleased] and became very ·powerful [great; strong].
- <sup>5</sup> While I was ·watching this [*or* reflecting; pondering], I saw a male goat come from the west. This goat had ·one large horn between his eyes that was easy to see [<sup>L</sup> a horn of vision; *or* a conspicuous horn between its eyes]. He crossed over the whole earth without touching the ground [<sup>C</sup> because of its speed].
- <sup>6</sup> ·In his anger [or With angry power] the goat ·charged [<sup>L</sup> came up to] the ·sheep [ram] with the two horns that I had seen standing by the ·canal [or gate]. <sup>7</sup> I watched the angry goat ·attack [approach] the ·sheep [ram] and break the ·sheep's [ram's] two horns. The ·sheep [ram] ·was not strong enough to stop him [<sup>L</sup> did not have the power/strength to stand before him]. The goat ·knocked [threw] the ·sheep [ram] to the ground and then ·walked all over him [trampled him].

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

No one was able to 'save [protect] the 'sheep [ram] from 'the goat [its power/<sup>L</sup> hand], <sup>8</sup> so the male goat became very 'great [powerful; strong]. But when he was strong, his 'big [or conspicuous] horn broke off and four horns grew in place of the one big horn. Those four horns 'pointed in four different directions [<sup>L</sup> were toward the four winds of heaven] and were 'easy to see [conspicuous].

- <sup>9</sup> Then ·a little horn grew from one of those four horns [<sup>L</sup> from one of them came out another horn, a little one; 7:8], and it became very ·big [great]. It grew to the south, the east, and toward the beautiful land [<sup>C</sup> Judah; Ezek. 20:6, 15]. <sup>10</sup> That ·little horn [<sup>L</sup> it] grew ·until it reached to the sky [<sup>L</sup> to the hosts of heaven; <sup>C</sup> the angels and the stars]. It even threw some of the ·army of heaven [<sup>L</sup> hosts and the stars] to the ground and ·walked on [trampled] them!
- <sup>11</sup> ·That little horn [<sup>L</sup> It] set itself up as equal to the prince of ·heaven's armies [<sup>L</sup> the hosts; <sup>C</sup> Yah]. It ·stopped [abolished] the ·daily [regular] sacrifices [Ex. 29:38–41; Num. 28:3–8] that were offered to him, and the ·Temple, the place where people worshiped him, [<sup>L</sup> place of the sanctuary] was ·pulled down [overthrown]. <sup>12</sup> Because there was a ·turning away from Yah [rebellion; transgression], the people stopped the ·daily [regular] sacrifices. Truth was thrown down to the ground, and ·the horn [<sup>L</sup> it] was successful in everything it did.
- <sup>13</sup> Then I heard ·a holy angel [<sup>L</sup> one of the holy ones] speaking. Another ·holy angel [<sup>L</sup> holy one] asked the first one, "How long will the things in this vision last—the ·daily [regular] sacrifices [8:12], the ·turning away from Yah [rebellion; transgression] that brings ·destruction [desolation], the ·Temple [sanctuary] being pulled down, and the ·army of heaven [host] being ·walked on [trampled]?"
- <sup>14</sup> The angel said to me, "<u>This will happen for twenty-three hundred evenings and mornings</u> [C either 2,300 or 1,150 days]. Then the 'holy place [sanctuary] will be 'repaired [restored; made right again]."
- <sup>15</sup> I, Daniel, saw this vision and ·tried to understand what it meant [<sup>L</sup> sought understanding]. I saw someone who looked like a man standing near me. <sup>16</sup> And I heard a man's voice calling from the Ulai ·Canal [or Gate]: "Gabriel [<sup>C</sup> an angel], explain the vision to this man."
- <sup>17</sup> ·Gabriel [<sup>L</sup>He] came to where I was standing. When he came close to me, I was ·very afraid [terrified; *or* overwhelmed] and ·bowed facedown on the ground [<sup>L</sup> fell on my face]. But ·Gabriel [<sup>L</sup>he] said to me, "·Human being [<sup>L</sup>Son of man], <u>understand that this vision is about the time</u> of the end."
- While 'Gabriel [Lhe] was speaking, I fell into a 'deep sleep [trance] with my face on the ground. Then he touched me [Strengthening him] and 'lifted me to my feet [Lmade me stand in my place]. He said, "Now, I will 'explain [make known; reveal] to you what will happen in the time of anger. Your vision was about the 'set [appointed] time of the end.

- <sup>20</sup> "You saw a 'male sheep [ram] with two horns, which are the kings of Media and Persia. <sup>21</sup> The male goat is the king of 'Greece [<sup>L</sup> Javan] and the big horn between its eyes is the first king [<sup>C</sup> Alexander the Great, who defeated Persia around 330 BC]. <sup>22</sup> The four horns that grew in the place of the broken horn are four kingdoms [<sup>C</sup> Alexander died in 323 BC and his four most powerful generals carved up his empire between them]. Those four kingdoms will come from 'the nation of the first king [<sup>L</sup> his nation], but 'they will not be as strong as the first king [<sup>L</sup> not with his power/strength].
- <sup>23</sup> "When the end comes near [When the time is running out] for those kingdoms, a ·bold and cruel [fierce/stern-faced] king who ·tells lies will come [Lunderstands riddles/enigmas;

  C Antiochus Epiphanes, who terrorized the Jews in the mid-second century BC]. This will happen when ·many people have turned against Yah [rebellions/transgressions will reach their height].
- <sup>24</sup> ·This king will be very powerful [LHis power will be strong], but ·his power will not come from himself [Lnot his own power]. He will cause ·terrible [fearful] destruction and will be successful in everything he does. He will destroy powerful people and even ·Yah's holy people [Lthe people of the holy ones].
- <sup>25</sup> This king will succeed by using ·lies and force [Lthe deceit in his hand/power]. He will ·think that he is very important [Lthe great/proud in his heart]. He will destroy many people ·without warning [or with ease]; he will ·try to fight [Lthe stand against] even the Prince of princes! But ·that cruel king [Lthe] will be ·destroyed [Lthe broken], and not by human ·power [Lthe hand]. [Daniel talks hewn/cut the stone, but not by human hands]
- <sup>26</sup> "The vision that has been shown to you about these evenings and mornings is true. But seal up the vision, because those things won't happen for a long time [Lit concerns many days from now]."
- <sup>27</sup> I, Daniel, became very weak and was sick for ·several days after that vision [<sup>L</sup> some days]. Then I got up and went back to work for the king, but I was very ·upset [dismayed; perplexed] about the vision. I didn't understand what it meant.

# (3) Who won the war?

The answer to this question is, the Ancient of Days is the one who won the war.

Now we know that Lucifer and those Angels who were in on the plot to try and get rid of the Ancient of Days are banished from Heaven; they have fallen to Earth. Some of them possible were imprisoned **UNDER THE EARTH!** The Book of Enoch and these verses **might** shed some light on the subject, because men and perhaps Angels are under the Earth;

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

#### Numbers 16:30

But if **Yahweh** make a new thing, and **the** <u>earth open her mouth</u>, and swallow **the**m up, with all that appertain unto **the**m, and **the**y go down quick into **the** pit; **the**n you shall **under**stand that **the**se men have provoked **Yah**.

#### **CEV**

But suppose Yah of Hosts does something that has never been done before. For example, what if a huge crack appears in the ground, and these men and their families fall into it and are buried alive, together with everything they own? Then you will know they have turned their backs on Yah of Hosts!"

ERV

But if Yah of Hosts causes them to die in a different way, then you will know that these men have sinned against Yah of Hosts. This is the proof: The earth will open and swallow them. They will go down to their grave still alive. And everything that belongs to these men will go down with them."

EHV

But if Yah of Hosts creates something unheard of and the ground opens its mouth and swallows them up with everything that belongs to them, and they go down alive into the grave, you will know that these men have treated Yah of Hosts with contempt."

Now turning to the Book of Enoch we will see something here;

(4) What Happened to those who lost?

#### THE BOOK OF ENOCH

#### **Chapter 2**

- 1 It happened after the sons of men had multiplied in those days, that daughters were born to them, elegant and beautiful.
- **2** And when the Watchers, [Angels] the sons of heaven, beheld them, they became enamoured of them, saying to each other, Come, let us select for ourselves wives from the progeny of men, and let us beget children.
- **3** Then their leader Samyaza said to them; I fear that you may perhaps be indisposed to the performance of this enterprise;
- **4** And that I alone shall suffer for so grievous a crime.
- **5** But they answered him and said; We all swear; And bind ourselves by mutual execrations, that we will not change our intention, but execute our projected undertaking.
- **6** Then they **swore all together**, and all bound themselves by mutual execrations. Their whole number was two hundred, who descended [*Went down*] upon Ardis, which is the top of mount Armon.

- **7** That mountain therefore was called Armon (a curse), because they had **sworn upon it**, and bound themselves by mutual execrations. [Oaths, insults, swearwords]
- **8** These are the names of <u>their chiefs:</u> Samyaza, <u>who was their leader</u>, Urakabarameel, Akibeel, Tamiel, Ramuel, Danel, Azkeel, Saraknyal, Asael, Armers, Batraal, Anane, Zavebe, Samsaveel, Ertael, Turel, Yomyael, <u>Arazyal</u>. These were the prefects of the two hundred Watchers, and the remainder were all with them.
- **9** Then <u>they took wives</u>, each choosing for himself; whom they began to approach, and with whom they cohabited; teaching them <u>sorcery</u>, <u>incantations</u>, and the dividing of roots and trees. Against Deuteronomy 29:29
- **10** And the women bore to the Watchers three races—first, the great giants.
- **11** The giants brought forth the Naphelim, and the Naphelim brought forth the Elioud. And they existed, increasing in power according to their greatness.
- **12** The <u>Giants stature</u> was each three hundred cubits [300 cubits equal 450 ft.]. These devoured all which the labor of men produced; until it became impossible to feed them;
- **13** When they turned themselves against men, in order to devour them; And began to injure birds, beasts, reptiles, and fishes, to eat their flesh one after another, and to eat one another's flesh and to **drink their blood**.
- **14** Then the earth reproved the unrighteous.
- **15** Moreover <u>Azazyel</u> taught men to make <u>swords</u>, knives, shields, breastplates, the fabrication of mirrors, and the workmanship of bracelets and ornaments, the use of paint, the beautifying of the eyebrows, the use of stones of every valuable and select kind, and all sorts of dyes/colors, so that the world became altered.
- 16 Impiety increased; fornication multiplied; and they transgressed and corrupted all their ways.
- 17 Amazarak taught all the sorcerers, and dividers of roots:
- **18** Armers taught the solution of **sorcery**;
- **19** Barkayal taught the observers of the stars, (9)
- 20 Akibeel taught signs;
- **21** Tamiel taught **astronomy**;

- **22** And Asaradel taught the motion/phases of the moon,
- 23 And men, being destroyed, cried out; and their voice reached to heaven.

# **Chapter 4**

1Then the Most High, the Great and Holy One spoke,

- **2** And <u>sent Arsayalalyur</u> (Uriel) to the son of Lamech, Saying, Say to him in my name, Conceal yourself.
- **3** Then explain to him the **consummation** which is about to take place; for all the earth shall perish; the waters of a deluge shall come over the whole earth, and all things which are in it shall be destroyed.
- **4** And now teach him how he may escape, and how his seed may remain in all the earth.
- **5** Again Yahweh said to Raphael, Bind Azazyel hand and foot; cast him into darkness; and opening the desert [Opening the ground located in a desert] which is in Dudael, Ancient Dudael is possibly where he was cast.

- 6 Throw upon him hurled and pointed stones, covering him with darkness;
- **7** There shall he remain for ever; cover his face, that he may not see the light.
- **8** And in the great day/year of judgment/punishment let him be cast into the fire.
- **9** Restore the earth, which the angels have corrupted; and announce life to it, that I may revive it.

- 10 All the sons of men shall not perish in consequence of every secret, by which the Watchers/Angels have destroyed, and which they have taught, their offspring.
- **11** All the earth has been corrupted by the effects of the teaching of Azazyel. To him therefore ascribe the whole crime.
- **12** To Gabriel also Yahweh said, Go to the bastards, to the reprobates, to the children of fornication; and destroy the children of fornication, the offspring of the Angels/Watchers, from among men; bring them forth, and excite [make them fight] them one against another.
- 13 Let them perish by mutual slaughter; for length of days shall not be theirs.
- **14** They shall all entreat you, but their fathers shall not obtain their wishes respecting them; for they shall hope for eternal life, and that they may live, each of them, five hundred years.
- **15** To Michael likewise Yahweh said, Go and announce his crime to Samyaza, and to the others who are with him, who have been associated with women, that they might be polluted with all their impurity.
- **16** And when all their sons shall be slain, when they shall see the perdition of their beloved, bind (Lock)
- them for seventy generations underneath the earth, even to the day of judgment, and of consummation, until the judgment, the effect of which will last for ever, be completed.
- **17** Then shall they be taken away into the **lowest depths of the fire** in torments; and in confinement shall they be shut up for ever.
- **18** Immediately after this shall he, Samyaza together with them, burn and perish; they shall be
- bound until the consummation [accumulation] time goes by of many generations.
- **19** Destroy all the souls addicted to lust, <u>and the offspring of the Watchers</u>, [*The Watchers are the Fallen Angels*] for they have tyrannized over mankind.
- **20** Let every oppressor perish from the face of the earth;
- **21** Let every evil work be destroyed;
- 22 The plant of righteousness and of rectitude appear, and its produce become a blessing.

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

- **23** Righteousness and rectitude shall be for ever planted with delight.
- **24** And then shall all the saints give thanks, and live until they have begotten a thousand children, while the whole period of their youth, and their sabbaths shall be completed in peace.
- **25** In those days all the earth shall be cultivated in righteousness; it shall be wholly planted with trees, and filled with benediction; every tree of delight shall be planted in it.
- **26** In it shall vines be planted; and the vine which shall be planted in it shall yield fruit to satiety; every seed, which shall be sown/planted in it, shall produce for one measure a thousand; and one measure of olives shall produce ten presses of oil.
- **27** Purify the earth from all oppression, from all injustice, from all crime, from all impiety, and from all the pollution which is committed upon it.
- 28 Exterminate them from the earth.
- **29** Then shall all the children of men be righteous, and all nations shall pay me divine honours, and bless me; and all shall adore me.
- **30** The earth shall be cleansed from all corruption, from every crime, from all punishment, and from all suffering; neither will I again send a deluge upon it from generation to generation for ever.
- **31** In those days I will open the treasures of blessing which are in heaven, that I may cause them to descend upon earth, and upon all the works and labour of man.
- **32** Peace and equity shall associate with the sons of men all the days of the world, in every generation of it.

#### **The Greek Book says this:**

• Revelation 5:3

And no man in heaven, nor in **earth**, neither <u>under the earth</u>, was able to open **the** book, neither to look **the**reon.

(5) As for the ones who lost, were they angry about losing, and what did they do (If anything) to the Earth, this place where they were cast down, because they were angry about being cast/thrown out of Heaven by Yahweh, and they couldn't live or go back to heaven.

We read much of the answer in the **Book of Enoch Chapter Four**, but read as much as you delight in the entire book of Enoch; as the book reveals a staggering viewpoint to consider.

#### This brings up some interesting Questions:

- 1. Since the Fallen Angels can't return to either the presence of Yahweh, or live inside of Yah's Thrown ever again, then
- 2. What did they *intentionally* do to make their new home on Earth change in order to be in their image; what would they do to alter the entire world and it's people living there?
- 3. Is it possible that the Fallen Angels sought to COMPLETELY REVERSE ENGINEER everything that Yahweh made that was perfect, THEREBY rendering it polluted?
- 4. Could this possibly lend credibility (<u>or a good reason in their eyes to swear and honor their oaths</u> <u>that they made to each other</u>; what motivated the Fallen Angels to corrupt the Earth and then file and acquire Copyrights from their associates which are other genetically altered men/angel hybrids? [<u>Genesis 6:2</u>]
- (6) Will there be a second war in heaven [In the skies over our heads] when it happens, will it be possibly in the "End Days/times"

#### Revelation 12:7

And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

#### Isaiah 8 Expanded Bible Assyria Will Come Soon

<sup>7</sup> So ·I, Yah of Hosts, [Llook/behold, Yah of Hosts] will bring against them a powerful flood of water from the 'Euphrates River [L River] the king of Assyria and all his power [glory].

The Assyrians will be like water rising [LIt will rise] over the banks of the river [its channels], flowing over 'the land [its banks].

<sup>8</sup> That water will 'flow [sweep] into Judah and pass through it, rising to 'Judah's throat [Lthe neck].

This army [LIt] will spread its wings like a bird

until it covers your whole country [the breadth/extent of our land], Immanuel [or God is with us]."

<sup>9</sup> ·Be broken [or You will be broken], all you nations, and [Lyou will] be ·smashed to pieces [shattered]. Listen, all you faraway ·countries [lands].

·Prepare for battle [TGird yourselves] and [you will] be ·smashed to pieces [shattered]! ·Prepare for battle [TGird yourselves] and [you will] be ·smashed to pieces [shattered]!

10 ·Make your plans for the fight [Devise your strategy], but 'they will be defeated [it will be thwarted].

·Give orders to your armies [LSpeak a command/word], but ·they will be useless [Lit will not stand],

because 'Yah is with us [LImmanuel].

We are <u>signs</u> and ·proofs [symbols; <u>warnings</u>; omens] for the people of Israel from Yah of Hosts ·All-Powerful [Almighty; of Heaven's Armies; <sup>T</sup> of hosts], who ·lives [dwells] on Mount Zion.

But I tell you that people should ask their God for help. Why should people who are still alive ask something from the dead? [or "Should not a nation consult their gods, asking the dead on behalf of the living?"; [Going to the grave yard/Cemetery talking to a corpse] in this interpretation the quotation continues to the end of the verse].

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>20</sup> ·You should follow the teachings and the agreement/*Covenant* that you made with With Yah of Hosts

 $\begin{bmatrix} ^{L} \end{bmatrix}$  (Look) to the law/instruction and to the testimony]. The mediums and fortune-tellers do not  $\begin{bmatrix} ^{L} \end{bmatrix}$  Those who do not; or If they do not] speak the word of Yah of Hosts  $\begin{bmatrix} ^{L} \end{bmatrix}$  according to this word], so their words are worth nothing [or] they are spiritually blinded; [or] they have no dawn].

<sup>21</sup> ·People will wander through the land [<sup>L</sup> They will pass through] ·troubled [*or* destitute] and hungry. # **Zechariah 14 The Voice (VOICE)**

1 Pay attention. The day for the Eternal is coming, *a day of judgment* when *your enemies* will plunder your goods and divide them right in front of you. <sup>2</sup> For I am going to incite all the nations to battle against Jerusalem. The city will be *surrounded and* taken. The houses will be ransacked; *all of your treasured possessions will be looted*.

Your wives and daughters will be raped. Half of the city will be forced into exile. The other half will remain in the city to pick up the pieces. <sup>3</sup> The Eternal One will join in the battle and fight against those enemy nations as your champion as He would on any day of any battle. <sup>4</sup> When that day comes, <u>His feet will stand securely on the Mount of Olives</u>, which sits east of Jerusalem.

The mountain will *quake under His weight and* split in two, divided by a wide valley that runs east to west. Half of the mountain will retreat to the north, the other half to the south. <sup>5</sup> That valley will become your escape route because the valley of My mountains will lead as far as Azel, and you shall run as you ran from the earthquake that hit during the reign of King Uzziah of Judah. *Once you are safe*, the Eternal my God will come to you with all His holy ones.

<sup>6</sup> On that day, there will be no light, no cold or biting frost. <sup>7</sup> There will be a single, continuous day—a unique kind of day known only to the Eternal One—when night does not eclipse the day and when light shines through the evening.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> On that day, living waters will stream out of Jerusalem. Half of them will flow to the eastern *Dead* Sea; the other half will *descend the hills and cross the plains to* join the western *Mediterranean* Sea. These waters will flow throughout the *dry* summer as they do in the *wet* winter. <sup>9</sup> And the Eternal will be *crowned as* King over all the earth. On that day, the Eternal will be one and His name will be one.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>10</sup> The *mountainous* land around Jerusalem will be turned into plains from Geba to Rimmon, south of the city. Jerusalem itself will *then* sit prominently in her place between Benjamin's gate, the location of the first gate, and the corner gate; she'll sit between Hananel's Tower and the royal winepresses. <sup>11</sup> And Jerusalem will remain secure, bustling with residents, <u>because she will never again be destined for destruction</u>.

The day of the Eternal One is coming. It is a day of judgment when a great final battle is fought. Jerusalem and her people are under attack; and the city, it seems, falls to her enemies. But ultimately, Yah's people do not fight alone. Yah of Hosts comes—commanding the army of heaven—to rescue and defend His people.

Ultimately, He is crowned King over all the earth. In that day, <u>Jerusalem</u> <u>is transformed and reinstated as Yah's holy city</u>; <u>it becomes the center of the world</u>, the source of life-giving waters. [*Ezekiel 47:1*] Even her enemies make pilgrimages to Jerusalem to worship and adore the one True God.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>12</sup> Every nation that attempts to wage war against Jerusalem will be struck with a plague. The Eternal will infect them *with a disease* making their flesh decay even as they stand, their eyes decay in their sockets, and their tongues decay in their mouths. <sup>13</sup> When that *horrible* day arrives, the Eternal will provoke them to panic, so that *in their confusion* they will grab each other *for safety and then turn* and attack each other.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>14</sup> Even Judah will *be forced to* fight in Jerusalem. And the riches of all the surrounding *enemy* nations will be gathered together—**gold**, **silver**, and *costly* **clothing** piled deep.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>15</sup> Then the same disease *that plagues the enemy forces* will infect the horses, mules, camels, donkeys—whatever domesticated animals <u>are in</u> their *battle* camps.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>16</sup> In days to come, all people who took up arms against Jerusalem *and survived will make a choice:* they will *either* journey to Jerusalem every year to keep the Feast of Booths and to worship the King—the Eternal, Commander of *heavenly* armies—<sup>17</sup> or the families of nations will refuse the journey to Jerusalem to adore the King, the Eternal, Commander of *heavenly* armies. The rains will never come to those *who refuse the journey*.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>18</sup> Even the family of *people known as* Egypt, if they do not come up to and travel through *the gates of Jerusalem* to present themselves *to Yah*, the Eternal will afflict them with the same plague of drought He'll use to crush those nations who won't keep the Feast of Booths.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>19</sup> This is the punishment Egypt and the *enemy* nations can expect if they refuse the journey to keep the Feast of Booths.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>20</sup> On that day, *every aspect of the land will be ritually pure*. Engraved on the bells worn by horses will be *the same phrase on the high priest's turban*: "Sacred to the Eternal One." The cooking pots used in the house of the Eternal will be *as sacred* as those *collection* bowls used at the altar.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>21</sup> In fact every pot in Jerusalem and Judah will be treated as sacred to the Eternal, Commander of heavenly armies, so that anyone who offers a sacrifice may borrow them and use them to boil

the meat of the sacrifice. In that day, no merchant [a] will be found in the temple of the Eternal, Commander of heavenly armies.

#### Psalms 11:4

But Yah is still in his holy temple; he still rules **from heaven**. [Hosea 5:15] He closely watches everything that happens here on earth.

#### Psalms 14:2

Ahayah/Yah looks down **from heaven** on all mankind to see if there are any who are wise, who want to please Yah.

#### Psalms 18:6

In my distress I screamed to Ahayah/Yah for his help. And he heard me **from heaven**; my cry reached his ears.

#### Psalms 18:16

He reached down **from heaven** and took me and drew me out of my great trials. He rescued me **from** deep waters.

Note: Spiritual/Symbolic Babylon/Egypt, - falls before the 490 years are over; do you remember that the Tents of Judah are saved first? [Zechariah 12:7]

Also, **remember**, the 70 year sentence of the Israelites in Ancient Babylon, this is mentioned in the time of Jeremiah, it had to be served before Yah's VISIT/rescue. THEN Babylon was punished!

#### Jeremiah 25:11

And this whole land shall be a desolation, and an astonishment; and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon **seventy years**.

#### Jeremiah 25:12

And it shall come to pass, when **seventy years** are accomplished, that I will punish the king of Babylon, and that nation, saith Yah, for their iniquity/sin, and the land of the Chaldeans, and will make it perpetual desolations.

Just think <u>the second exodus</u> is out of the North Country <u>after</u> 400 years of the 490 year sentence is served in The North Country (*Genesis 15:16*)

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

#### Jeremiah 23:7-8 King James Version

<sup>7</sup> Therefore, behold, the days come, says Yah, that they [Israelites] shall no more say, Yah lives, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

<sup>8</sup> But, Yah lives, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.

In this same way, the Spiritual Babylon of our time and day will be punished after our people have served 400 of the 490 years in Spiritual Babylon told to us in Genesis 15<sup>th</sup> chapter.

But since the return/relief of Yah is after the time of punishment/sentencing of His people this will happen in the two times of punishment mentioned here (Jeremiah 25:12 and Genesis 15:13-14)

#### Genesis 15:13-14 king James Version

And he said unto Abram, Know of a <u>surety</u> that your seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and <u>shall serve them</u>; and <u>they shall afflict/distress</u> them <u>four hundred years</u>;

And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge/punish: <u>and afterward</u> shall they come out with great substance.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** After the 400 years of slavery in the North American Continent, there still is 7 years left of the 490 year sentence of punishment.

Looking at scriptures, I believe that half way thru the last seven years, which would be in the middle of Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> week (*Daniel 9:27*), the remnant of the Children of Israel who escape with their lives will then leave the North Country to serve the remainder [**Or second half**] of the last 7 years on the slopes of the mountains of Israel outside of Jerusalem for a time, times, and a ½ time (*Daniel 7:25*) [3 ½ years]

#### Micah 7:14

<sup>15</sup> I will show you<sup>[a]</sup> wonders

as you saw in the days when you came out of Egypt;

They will creep out of their holes, shivering in terror because of You.

They turn to the Eternal, our True God, filled with dread, and they stand in awe of You.

This time is a time for total cleansing. Those who don't pass the cleaning will never make it to Jerusalem see the scripture below↓

#### Ezekiel 20:38

I will get rid of [purge out] those who refuse to obey me [revolt] and who turn [Go back to worshiping false gods] [rebel] against me. I will bring them out of the land where they are now living, but they will never enter the land of Israel. Then you will know that I am Yah,- Ahayah.

But There is something else to remember, the  $70^{th}$  week or last 7 years must be completed before Yah can return to Jerusalem, so Yah punishes the end-day spiritual Egypt/Babylon from Heaven; Look once more at the below scriptures  $\downarrow$ 

#### Isaiah 6:1

His bright glory fills the whole earth. [Shines upon the Earth and people can see it from the Earth]

The foundations trembled at the sound of the angel voices, and then the whole house filled with smoke. I said, "Doom! It's Doomsday! I'm as good as dead! Every word I've ever spoken is tainted—blasphemous even!



All Yah's wonders and goodness are done for Israel's benefit according to His great mercy and compassion.

Everything that we have examined up to this point is very important. We can now think of the following points:

- **The New Testament**, coming from the Greek Empire (It was written several decades after the death of their God called Jesus Christ.)
- Their means of worship and inclusion of members with their rituals of initiations with their set of Holyday's called Holidays.
- As they are different from the Hebrew Israelites, these initiates worship a god head, meaning the 3 aspects of their beliefs; the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, often mentioned as the "Holy Ghosts"
- Many teachings are taught on the opinions of the book's authors, and are not based upon the principals laid down by the Almighty God.
- The Greeks had a panel of gods which would transfer to the Roman Empire when the Greek Empire was defeated by the Romans, but the gods would be assigned different names, but similar in nature and position in respect to the Greek's gods.

This *is* My name forever, and this *is* My memorial to all generations.' <sup>16</sup> Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them, 'AhaYah/Yah God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared to me, saying, "I have surely visited you and *seen* what is done to you in Egypt; <sup>17</sup> and I have said I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt to the land of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, to a land flowing with milk and honey." '

- (2) As different from the Hebrew Israelites, these initiates worship a god head, meaning 3 aspects of their beliefs the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, often mentioned as the "Holy Ghost"
- (3) Many teachings are taught on the opinions of the book's authors, and are not based upon the principals laid down by the Almighty God, Yahweh!
- (4) The Greek Empire had a panel of gods which transferred to the Roman Empire when the Greeks were defeated by the Romans. These same gods would be assigned different names, but were similar in status and position in respect to the Greek's gods.

There are many major differences; that are not only between the people and their cultures, but also between the Two Books that govern most of the people called, The Old and New Testaments. Many books were taken out of the Old Testament, (Torah) and have been hidden for many years by the elements of evil from the general population. We are coming near to the discussion of why there are 2 books in the Bible from two different sources; (1) Almighty God and (2) Man.

The Bible is fundamentally and spiritually different, as one book solely worships the Creator, and the other book is used to control the thoughts and ideas of earth's people by certain men and women in power. To be continued...

# Deuteronomy 12 Expanded Bible

# The Place for Worship

These are the ·commands [statutes; ordinances; requirements] and laws you must carefully obey in the land Yah of Hosts, the God of your ·ancestors [fathers], is giving you to possess. Obey them as long as you live in the land. <sup>2</sup> When you ·inherit [possess] the lands of these nations, **you must completely destroy all the places where they serve their gods**, on high mountains and hills and under every green tree (groves). <sup>3</sup> Tear down their altars, smash their holy stone pillars, and burn their ·Asherah idols [Lasherim; 7:5; Judg. 3:7] in the fire. Cut down their idols and destroy their names from those places.

<sup>4</sup>Don't ·worship [act for] Yah of Hosts your God that way, <sup>5</sup> but look for the place Yah of Hosts your God will choose—·a place among your tribes where he is to be worshiped [Las his dwelling where he will place his name]. Go there, <sup>6</sup> and bring to that place your burnt offerings [Lev. 1:1–17] and sacrifices; bring ·a tenth of what you gain [Tyour tithes] and your special gifts; bring what you have ·promised [vowed] and the special gifts you want to give Yah of Hosts, and bring the first animals born to your herds and flocks.

To that place you must bring everything I 'tell [command] you: your burnt offerings [Lev. 1:1–17] and sacrifices, your 'offerings of a tenth of what you gain [ $^{T}$  tithes], your special gifts, and all your best things you 'promised [vowed] to Yah of Hosts.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> There you and your families <u>will eat in the presence of Yah of Hosts</u>, and you will enjoy all the good things for which you have worked [your undertakings; <sup>L</sup> all that is sent out from your hand], because Yah of Hosts your God has blessed you.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> Do not ·worship [act] the way we have been ·doing [acting] today, <u>each person doing what</u> ·he thinks is right [Lis right/virtuous in his own eyes [your opinion]. <sup>9</sup> You have not yet come to a resting place, to the ·land [Linheritance] Yah of Hosts your God will give you as your own.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>10</sup> But soon you will cross the Jordan River to live in the land Yah of Hosts your God is 'giving you as your own [<sup>L</sup> causing you to inherit], where he will give you rest from all your enemies and you will live in safety [2 Sam. 7:1; <sup>C</sup> David would achieve rest from enemies; Solomon would build the temple in an era (time) of peace].

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>11</sup> <u>Then</u> Yah of Hosts your God will choose a place where he ·is to be worshiped [<sup>L</sup> will cause his name to dwell; <sup>C</sup> Zion, where the Temple would be built].

# \*\* Take Notice \*\*

1. Is a man or woman who is sick or has a discharge/infection of some type from their body considered ritually clean; able to be in the presence of Yah of Hosts, and or present an offering to Him? Here are just a few examples:

# **Leviticus 5:2**

"Or someone might touch something unclean, such as the dead body of an unclean wild animal or an unclean farm animal or an unclean crawling animal [11:24–28, 32–40]. Even if he does not know that he touched it, he will still be unclean and guilty of sin.

#### Leviticus 5:3

"Someone might touch human **unclean**ness—anything **that** makes someone **unclean**—and not know it. But when **he** learns about it, **he** will be guilty.

# Leviticus 7:20

But if anyone is **unclean** and eats the meat from the ·fellowship [*or* peace; well-being] offering [3:1] **that** belongs to Yah of Hosts, **he** must be cut off from his people.

### Leviticus 15th chapter

### Rules about a Person's Body

Yah of Hosts also said to Moses and Aaron, <sup>2</sup> "Say to the 'people [<sup>L</sup> sons; children] of Israel: 'When 'a fluid comes from a person's body [<sup>L</sup> any man has a discharge from his genitals/flesh], the 'fluid is [discharge makes him] unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense]. <sup>3</sup> It doesn't matter if the 'fluid

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>12</sup> There rejoice before Yah of Hosts your God. Everyone should rejoice: you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, and the Levites ·from your towns [Lin your gates] who have no ·land [allotment] of their own. <sup>13</sup> Be careful that you don't sacrifice your burnt offerings [Lev. 1:1–17] just anywhere you ·please [Lin See]. <sup>14</sup> Offer them only in the place Yah of Hosts will choose [Zion; v. 11]. Do not eat in your own 'towns [L gates] what belongs to Yah of Hosts: 'one-tenth [T a tithe] of your grain, new wine, or oil; the first animals born to your herds or flocks; whatever you have 'promised to give [vowed]; the special gifts you want to give to Yah of Hosts, or any other gifts.

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

[discharge] flows freely or if it is blocked from ·flowing [discharging]; the ·fluid [discharge] will make him unclean. This is the way the ·fluid [discharge] makes him unclean:

<sup>4</sup> "If the person ·who discharges the body fluid [with the discharge] lies on a bed, that bed becomes unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense], and everything he sits on becomes unclean. <sup>5</sup> Anyone who touches his bed must wash his clothes and bathe in water, and the person will be unclean until evening. <sup>6</sup> Whoever sits on something that the person ·who discharges the fluid [with the discharge] sat on must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean until evening. <sup>7</sup> Anyone who touches the person ·who discharges the body fluid [with the discharge] must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean until evening.

<sup>8</sup> "If the person ·who discharges the body fluid [with the discharge] spits on someone who is clean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense], that person must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean until evening. <sup>9</sup> Everything on which the person who is unclean sits when riding [<sup>C</sup> specifically a saddle] will become unclean. <sup>10</sup> Anyone who touches something that was under him will be unclean until evening. And anyone who carries these things must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean until evening.

<sup>11</sup> "If the person ·who discharges a body fluid [with a discharge] has not washed his hands in water and touches another person, that person must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense] until evening.

<sup>12</sup> "If a person who discharges a body fluid [with a discharge] touches a clay bowl, that bowl must be broken. If he touches a wooden bowl, that bowl must be washed in water.

<sup>13</sup> "When a person 'who discharges a body fluid [with a discharge] is made clean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense], he must count seven days for himself for his cleansing. He must wash his clothes and bathe his body in fresh water, and he will be clean. <sup>14</sup> On the eighth day he must take two doves or two young pigeons before Yah of Hosts at the entrance of the Meeting Tent. He will give the two birds to the priest. <sup>15</sup> The priest will offer the birds, one for a sin [*or* purification; <u>4:3</u>] offering and the other for a burnt offering [<u>1:1–17</u>]. And the priest will make that person clean 'so he can belong to Yah of Hosts again [<sup>L</sup> and make atonement for him].

<sup>16</sup> "If semen [<sup>C</sup> considered holy due to its association with life] goes out from a man, he must bathe in water; he will be unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense] until evening [<sup>C</sup> contact with something holy also rendered a person unclean]. <sup>17</sup> If the fluid gets on any clothing or leather, it must be washed with water; it will be unclean until evening.

<sup>18</sup> "If a man has sexual relations [Lies] with a woman [Cpresumably his wife] and semen comes out [has an emission of semen], both people must bathe in water; they will be unclean [Lies] in a ritual sense] until evening.

### Rules About a Woman's Body

<sup>19</sup> "When a woman has 'her monthly period [<sup>L</sup> a discharge of blood from her genitals/body], she is unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense; the blood's association with reproduction makes it holy; <u>15:16</u>] for seven days; anyone who touches her will be unclean until evening. <sup>20</sup> Anything she lies on during this time will be unclean, and everything she sits on during this time will be unclean. <sup>21</sup> Anyone who touches her bed must wash his clothes and bathe in water; that person will be unclean until evening. <sup>22</sup> Anyone who touches something she has sat on must wash his clothes and bathe in water; that person will be unclean until evening. <sup>23</sup> It does not matter if the person touched the woman's bed or something she sat on; he will be unclean until evening.

<sup>24</sup> "If a man ·has sexual relations with a woman [lies with her] and her ·monthly period [discharge] touches him, he will be unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense] for seven days; every bed he lies on will be unclean.

<sup>25</sup> "If a woman has a ·loss [discharge] of blood for many days and it is not during her regular monthly period, or if she continues to have a ·loss [discharge] of blood after her regular period, she will be unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense], as she is during her monthly period. She will be unclean for as long as she continues to bleed [Matt. 9:20; Mark 5:25; Luke 8:43]. <sup>26</sup> Any bed she lies on during all the time of her ·bleeding [discharge] will be like her bed during her regular monthly period. Everything she sits on will be unclean, as during her regular monthly period.

<sup>27</sup> "Whoever touches those things will be unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense] and must wash his clothes and bathe in water; he will be unclean until evening. <sup>28</sup> When the woman becomes clean from her bleeding [discharge], she must 'wait [<sup>L</sup> count] seven days, and after this she will be clean.

<sup>29</sup> Then on <u>the eighth day</u> she must take two doves or two young pigeons and bring them to the priest at the entrance of the Meeting Tent. <sup>30</sup> The priest must offer one bird for a sin [*or* purification; <u>4:3</u>] offering and the other for a whole burnt offering [<u>1:1-17</u>]. In this way the priest will make her clean so she can belong to Yah of Hosts again [<sup>L</sup> and make atonement for her].

[You might be asking why would one have to do this, because of Genesis 3<sup>rd</sup> chapter EVE having <u>sex</u> w/Satan/ the cherub <u>angel</u>, and her punishment which is hard labor and all the pains of childbirth]

 $^{31}$  "So you must warn the 'people [ $^{L}$  sons; children] of Israel to stay separated from things that make them unclean [ $^{C}$  in a ritual sense]. If you don't warn the people, they might make my 'Holy Tent [Tabernacle] unclean, and then they would have to die!"

<sup>32</sup> These are the 'teachings [laws; instructions] for the person who 'discharges a body fluid [has a discharge] and for the man who becomes unclean [<sup>C</sup> in a ritual sense] from 'semen coming out of his body [an emission of semen].

Thus says Yah of Hosts, your Redeemer, and He Who formed you from the womb: I am Yah of Hosts, Who made all things, Who alone stretched out the heavens, Who spread out the earth by Myself [who was with Me]?—

<sup>33</sup> These are the 'teachings [laws; regulations] for the woman who becomes unclean from her monthly period, for a man or woman who has a discharge, and for a man who 'becomes unclean by having sexual relations [<sup>L</sup> lies] with a woman who is unclean.

## Leviticus 19:15

<sup>15</sup> He told them, "Get ready for Yah's appearance <u>two days from now</u>, <u>and do not have sexual intercourse with your wives." [Semen comes out of a man during sexual intercourse</u>]

This is also why our people were told to not do this prior when Yahweh was coming to visit Israel:

#### Exodus 19:9-15

- <sup>9</sup> Then he said to Moses, "I am going to come to you in the form of a dark cloud, so that the people themselves can hear me when I talk with you, and then they will always believe you.
- <sup>10</sup> Go down now and see that the people are ready for my visit. Sanctify them today and tomorrow, and have them wash their clothes. <sup>11</sup> Then, the day after tomorrow, I will come down upon Mount Sinai as all the people watch.
- <sup>12</sup> Set boundary lines the people may not pass, and tell them, 'Beware! Do not go up into the mountain or even touch its boundaries; whoever does shall die— <sup>13</sup> no hand shall touch him, but he shall be stoned or shot to death with arrows, whether man or animal.' Stay away from the mountain entirely until you hear a ram's horn sounding one long blast; then gather at the foot of the mountain!"
- <sup>14</sup> So Moses went down to the people and sanctified them and they washed their clothing.


The priests answered, "Yes, it would become unclean."



I brought out these scriptures to prove to you some of the things that make us unclean. I want you to think about 10% of money in the form of tithes.


- 1. Is the United States Dollar unclean?

## THE US DOLLAR (MONEY)










That small image is a Owl. It is also used as a sacrificial altar at the Bohemian Grove



Notice the face is lighted, and the western side is dark. This country was just beginning. We had not begun to explore the west or decided what we could do for Western Civilization. ## **Hoo! Is Moloch?**



## Moloch Owl | OVO

After the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah and losing his wife; Lot had two sons. One by each of his daughters. Some beliefs state that his daughters seduced him to bear their children; other religious beliefs do not agree such events took place. However, Lot did in fact have two sons; Moab who was father of the Moabites and the Kingdom of Moab and Ben-ammi who was father to the Ammonites and the Kingdom of Ammon. While closely related to the Israelite's ethnically, their culture or religious beliefs were completely opposite and they were frequently in conflict with each other. The Moabite stone at Dibon records 9th century victories in Israel and how their oppression over the Moabites had angered their god Chemosh. As for the Ammonites, their god was Milcom or Molech/Moloch.


These two groups were probably more closely related than any others at the time. Both of their gods are symbols of human statures with horned ox or bull-like animal heads. Both of these gods are given child sacrifices; Molech/Moloch generally receiving burnt sacrifices. It is said that Tophet, is the land of the Valley of Hinnon/Gehenna where they made their burnt sacrifices to Molech. This is probably how Gehenna has become synonymous with a fiery hell.

The Ammonites religion is referred to as Milkomite, which is the worship of Moloch. However, their god is initially named Milcom. Even though they must be closely related, Moloch is also referred to as a sacrificial "act" at times as well. Moloch/Molech is an understanding of a child sacrifice, generally at the hand of the parents. (Leviticus 18:21–23: "And thou shalt not let any of thy seed pass through the fire to Moloch" & "followers of various Ba'als and Canaanite gods, including Moloch, "sacrificed their children by fire" 2 Chr. 28:3, 33:6; Jer. 7:31, 19:2-6. Lev xviii.21, "Israelite is forbidden to sacrifice any of his children to Molech")

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A molk or mulk sacrifice would insist that the abomination was not in worshiping the god Molech/Moloch who demanded children to be sacrificed to him, but in the practice of sacrificing human children as molk. The Hebrew letters \( \text{mth} \) which represent "mlk" translate to melek or "the king." These letters were used to refer to the status of the sacrificial god within his cult. While almost no physical evidence of a god referred to as Moloch or by any similar epithet seems to exist so from this we can probably gather that if such a god did exist, the name Moloch/Molech was evident ally not the name known by his worshipers, but rather a Hebrew transliteration. (http://www.newworldencyclopedia.org/entry/Moloch)

In the late 1800's, the Californian gold rush had a distinct effect on the population. It brought about a majority of uneducated, uncultured people into an already established society. In order to maintain their values and culture an all male private club was born in San Francisco in 1872. The Bohemian Club; located in the same building as the Olympic Club, which had been similarly established in 1860 (the oldest athletic club in US). The building can be located on Post Street and it is said that the original building was destroyed due to the earthquake, and was later rebuilt in 1912. The Bohemian Club was for journalists, artists, the educated and wealthy. This private club was for members of a common creed to enjoy activities of common interest. Present day the club is still in existence with the worlds elite as its members. Their



retreat is located amidst ancient Coast Redwoods which are renowned for their age, which can be up to 2,000 years old. These massive all covering Sequoiodeae easily grow to 300 feet tall. This I would imagine creates a rich, almost enchanted world of its own. Within the compounds, near the stage sits a 35-40 foot stone owl, commonly referred to as Moloch. It has been widely documented that before this god a ceremonial sacrifice is held every year during the cremation of care event. Here is where our "leaders" either watch or participate in a completely taboo display including fire, the owl of course with his fire altar, monk-like robes, a supposed "fake" body to sacrifice just to name the ones that have been leaked. Who knows what the remaining festivities include if that is the kickoff. But what is confusing here is moloch=owl? Initially this can be written off as being named moloch as the type of sacrifice being preformed, and due to the fact it is "burnt". The owl however, is no where in connection with what we know about this name. The owl itself is associated with wisdom, the knowing of secrets, bringer of ill health, bad luck, destruction and bad omens. Lilith the demonic figure that is said to have been Adams' first wife also shown with owls. Hebrew (ISO 259): u-pagu iyyim et-iyyim w-sair al-ēēhu yiqra; ak-šam hirgia lilit u-maa lah manoa. 34:14 "And shall-meet desert creatures et (particle) jackals the goat he-calls hisfellow lilit (lilith) she-rests and she-finds rest. 34:15 there she-shall-nest the great-owl, and shelays-(eggs), and she-hatches, and she-gathers under her-shadow: hawks[kites, gledes] also theygather, every one with its mate.
