Genealogy/(Bloodline)

Abram's birth and parents:

Abram was born after the flood of Noah's time when Nimrod was King of the geographical area known as Mesopotamia, but is more commonly called Babylon. Abram was growing up during

the time of the "Tower of Babel." This area today is called the Middle East or primarily the greater Iraq nation and surrounding area. Abram was from the land of Ur.

Genesis 11:28

And Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his nativity, in **Ur** of the Chaldees.

Genesis 11:10-32

¹⁰These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood:

¹¹ And Shem lived after he begat Arphaxad five hundred years, and begat sons and daughters.

¹² And Arphaxad lived five and thirty years, and begat Salah:

¹³ And Arphaxad lived after he begat Salah four hundred and three years, and begat sons and daughters.

¹⁴ And Salah lived thirty years, and begat Eber:

¹⁵ And Salah lived after he begat Eber four hundred and three years, and begat sons and daughters.

¹⁶ And Eber lived four and thirty years, and begat Peleg:

¹⁷ And Eber lived after he begat Peleg four hundred and thirty years, and begat sons and daughters.

¹⁸ And Peleg lived thirty years, and begat Reu:

¹⁹ And Peleg lived after he begat Reu two hundred and nine years, and begat sons and daughters.

²⁰ And Reu lived two and thirty years, and begat Serug:

²¹ And Reu lived after he begat Serug two hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters.

²² And Serug lived thirty years, and begat Nahor:

²³ And Serug lived after he begat Nahor two hundred years, and begat sons and daughters.

²⁴ And Nahor lived nine and twenty years, and begat Terah:

²⁵ And Nahor lived after he begat Terah an hundred and nineteen years, and begat sons and daughters.

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²⁶ And Terah lived seventy years, and begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran.

²⁷ Now these are the generations of Terah: Terah begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran; and Haran begat Lot.

²⁸ And Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his nativity, in Ur of the Chaldees.

²⁹ And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife was Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah.

³⁰But Sarai was barren; she had no child.

³¹ And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went <u>forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go</u> <u>into the land of Canaan</u>; and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.

³² And the days of Terah were two hundred and five years: and Terah died in Haran.

Genesis 11:29

And **Abram** and Nahor took them wives: the name of **Abram**'s wife was Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the **father** of Milcah, and the **father** of Iscah.

At this time Yahweh calls Abram and family from the land where he was born to a new location where Terah Abram's father settled in the land of Canaan. It may be important to note that the family is moving westward to what will become the "Holy Land." This migration or relocation did not happen in a day or two, but will take some time accomplishing the family's moving; possibly years.

Genesis 12:1

Now Yahweh had said unto **Abram**, Get you out of your (Homeland) country, and from your kindred, and <u>from your father's house</u>, unto a land that I will show you:

Now if you are careful, notice where Abram was called from and where he is now living; remember Terah his father is living in the land of Canaan.

Genesis 12 Names of God Bible (NOG)

YHWH's First Promise to Abram

1 Yahweh said to Abram,

"Leave your land, your relatives,

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and your father's home.
Go to the land that I will show you.
² I will make you a great nation,
I will bless you.
I will make your name great,
and you will be a blessing.
³ I will bless those who bless you,
and whoever curses you, I will curse.
Through you every family on earth will be blessed."

YHWH's Second Promise to Abram

⁴ So Abram left, as *Yahweh* had told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was 75 years old when he left Haran. ⁵ Abram set out for Canaan. He took along his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, and all the possessions they had accumulated and the servants they had acquired in Haran.

⁶ They arrived in Canaan,^[a] and Abram traveled through the land <u>to the oak tree</u> <u>belonging to Moreh at Shechem</u>. At that time the Canaanites were in the land. ⁷ Then *Yahweh* appeared to Abram and said, "I'm going to give this land to your descendants." So he built an altar there to *Yahweh*, who had appeared to him.

⁸ He moved on to the hills east of Bethel, and he put up his tent—with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. He also built an altar to *Yahweh* there and worshiped *Yahweh*. ⁹ Abram kept moving toward the Negev.

Abram Deceives Pharaoh

¹⁰There was a famine in the land. Abram went to Egypt to stay awhile because the famine was severe. ¹¹When he was about to enter Egypt, Abram said to his wife Sarai, "I know that you're a beautiful woman. ¹²When the Egyptians see you, they'll say, 'This is his wife!' Then they'll kill me but let you live. ¹³Please say that you're my sister. Then everything will be alright for me, and because of you I will live."

¹⁴ When Abram arrived in Egypt, the Egyptians saw how very beautiful his wife was. ¹⁵ When Pharaoh's officials saw her, they raved about her to Pharaoh, so Sarai was taken to Pharaoh's palace. ¹⁶ Everything went well for Abram because of her, and he was given sheep, cattle, donkeys, male and female slaves, and camels.

¹⁷ However, *Yahweh* struck Pharaoh and his household with terrible plagues because of Sarai, Abram's wife. ¹⁸ Then Pharaoh called for Abram. "What have you done to me?" he asked. "Why didn't you tell me that she's your wife? ¹⁹ Why did you say, 'She's my sister' and allow me to take her for my wife? Here's your wife! Take her and go!" ²⁰ Pharaoh gave his men orders concerning Abram. They sent Abram away with his wife and everything that he had.

Genesis 20:18

For Yahweh had completely closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech because of **Sarah**, Abraham's wife.

Genesis 17 Names of God Bible (NOG)

YHWH's Fifth Promise to Abraham (Covenant)

1 When Abram was 99 years old, *Yahweh* appeared to him. He said to Abram, "I am *El Shadday*. Live in my presence with integrity. ² I will give you my promise,^[a] and I will give you very many descendants." ³ Immediately, Abram bowed with his face touching the ground, and again *Elohim* spoke to him, ⁴ "My promise is still with you. You will become the father of many nations. ⁵ So your name will no longer be Abram [Exalted Father], but Abraham [Father of Many] because I have made you a father of many nations. ⁶ I will give you many descendants. Many nations and kings will come from you.

⁷ I will make my promise to you and your descendants for generations to come as an everlasting promise. I will be your *Elohim* and the God of your descendants. ⁸ I am also giving this land where you are living—all of Canaan—to you and your descendants as your permanent possession. And I will be your *Elohim*."

⁹*Elohim* also said to Abraham, "You and your descendants in generations to come are to be faithful to my promise. ¹⁰ This is how you are to be faithful to my promise: Every male among you is to be circumcised. ¹¹ All of you must be circumcised. That will be the sign of the promise from me to you. ¹² For generations to come every male child who is eight days old must be circumcised, whether he is born in your household or bought with money from a foreigner who's not related to you.

¹³ Every male born in your household or bought with your money is to be circumcised without exception. So my promise will be a sign on your flesh, an everlasting promise. ¹⁴ Any uncircumcised male must be excluded from his people because he has rejected my promise."

¹⁵ *Elohim* said to Abraham, "Don't call your wife by the name Sarai anymore. Instead, her name is Sarah [Princess]. ¹⁶ I will bless her, and I will also give you a son by her. I will bless her, and she will become a mother of nations, and kings will come from her." ¹⁷ Immediately, Abraham bowed with his face touching the ground. He laughed as he thought to himself, "Can a son be born to a hundred-year-old man? Can Sarah, a ninety-year-old woman, have a child?" ¹⁸ Then Abraham said to *Elohim*, "Why not let Ishmael be my heir?"

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¹⁹ *Elohim* replied, "No! Your wife Sarah will give you a son, and you will name him Isaac [He Laughs]. I will make an everlasting promise to him and his descendants. ²⁰ I have heard your request about Ishmael. Yes, I will bless him, make him fertile, and increase the number of his descendants. He will be the father of 12 princes, and I will make him a great nation. ²¹ But I will make my promise to Isaac. Sarah will give birth to him at this time next year." ²² When *Elohim* finished speaking with Abraham, he left him.

Abraham's Household Circumcised

²³ So Abraham took his son Ishmael, everyone born in his household, and everyone bought with money—every male in his household—and circumcised them that day, as *Elohim* had told him.
²⁴ Abraham was 99 years old when he was circumcised. ²⁵ His son Ishmael was 13 years old when he was circumcised. ²⁶ That same day Abraham and his son Ishmael were circumcised.
²⁷ All the men of his household, whether born in the household or bought with money from a foreigner, were circumcised with him.

Footnotes:

a. Genesis 17:2 or "Covenant."

Abraham has now left his father's household and land, and he now also has a wife (Sarah) were a personal Covenant or agreement is made between Yahweh and Abraham that would pass down a certain genealogical line thru Isaac who would father Jacob and in turn have 12 sons that would grow up into the nation of Israel. These are the names of the twelve sons: Asher, Dan, Judah, Simeon, *Reuben, Levi, Naphtali, Issachar, Zebulin, Gad, Dan, and Joseph. (Genesis 49th chapter)

Those who hate you hold their heads high. <u>They make plans in secret against your people</u> and plot together against those you treasure.

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4 They say, "Let's wipe out their nation so that the name of Israel will no longer be remembered." 5 They agree completely on their plan. They form an alliance against you: 6 the tents from Edom and Ishmael, Moab and Hagar, 7 Gebal, Ammon, and Amalek, Philistia, along with those who live in Tyre. 8 Even Assyria has joined them. They helped the descendants of Lot. Selah ⁹ Do to them what you did to Midian, to Sisera and Jabin at the Kishon River. ¹⁰ They were destroyed at Endor. They became manure to fertilize the ground. ¹¹ Treat their influential people as you treated Oreb and Zeeb. Treat all their leaders like Zebah and Zalmunna. ¹² They said, "Let's take *Elohim's* pasturelands for ourselves." ¹³ O my *Elohim*, blow them away like tumbleweeds,^[a] like husks in the wind. ¹⁴ Pursue them with your storms, and terrify them with your windstorms ¹⁵ the way fire burns a forest and flames set mountains on fire.^[b] ¹⁶Let their faces blush with shame, O Yahweh, so that they must look to you for help. ¹⁷ Let them be put to shame and terrified forever. Let them die in disgrace ¹⁸ so that they must acknowledge you. Your name is *Yahweh*. You alone are *Elyon* (God) of the whole earth. Footnotes: a. Psalm 83:13 Or "whirling dust." b. Psalm 83:15 Verse 15 (in Hebrew) has been placed in front of verse 14 to express the complex Hebrew sentence structure more clearly in English.

Exodus 34 Living Bible (TLB)

34 Yahweh told Moses, "Prepare two stone tablets like the first ones, and I will write upon them the same commands that were on the tablets you broke. ² Be ready in the morning to come up into Mount Sinai and present yourself to me on the top of the mountain. ³ No one shall come with you and no one must be anywhere on the mountain. Do not let the flocks or herds feed close to the mountain."

⁴ So Moses took two tablets of stone like the first ones, and was up early and climbed Mount Sinai, as Yahweh had told him to, taking the two stone tablets in his hands.

⁵⁻⁶ Then Yahweh descended in the form of a pillar of cloud and stood there with him, and passed in front of him and announced the meaning of his name.^[a] "I am Yahweh, the merciful and gracious God," he said, "slow to anger and rich in steadfast love and truth. ⁷ I, Yahweh, show this steadfast love to many thousands by forgiving their sins; ^[b] or else* I refuse to clear the guilty, and require that a father's sins be punished in the sons and grandsons, and even later generations." (Third and Fourth Generation, - 400 years)

⁸ Moses fell down before Yahweh and worshiped. ⁹ And he said, "If it is true that I have found favor in your sight, O Yahweh, then please go with us to the Promised Land; yes, it is an unruly, stubborn people, but pardon our iniquity and our sins, and accept us as your own."

¹⁰ Yahweh replied, "All right, this is the contract I am going to make with you. I will do miracles such as have never been done before anywhere in all the earth, and all the people of Israel shall see the power of Yahweh—the terrible power I will display through you. ¹¹ <u>Your part of the</u> <u>agreement is to obey all of my commandments</u>; then I will drive out from before you the Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites.

¹² "Be very, very careful never to compromise with the people there in the land where you are going, for if you do, you will soon be following their evil ways. ¹³ Instead, you must break down their heathen altars, smash the obelisks they worship, and cut down their shameful idols.^[\underline{c}] ¹⁴ For you must worship no other gods, but only Yahweh, for he is a God who claims absolute loyalty and exclusive devotion.

¹⁵ "No, do not make a peace treaty of any kind with the people living in the land, for they are spiritual prostitutes, committing adultery against me by sacrificing to their gods.^[d] If you become friendly with them and one of them invites you to go with him and worship his idol, you are apt to do it. ¹⁶ And you would accept their daughters, who worship other gods, as wives for your sons—and then your sons would commit adultery against me by worshiping their wives' gods. ¹⁷ You must have nothing to do with idols.

¹⁸ "Be sure to celebrate the Feast of Unleavened Bread for seven days, just as I instructed you, at the dates appointed each year in March;(in this translation, nevertheless, springtime) (Late March or April) that was the month you left Egypt.

¹⁹ "Every firstborn male^[e] is mine—cattle, sheep, and goats. ²⁰ The firstborn colt of a donkey may be redeemed by giving a lamb in its place. If you decide not to redeem it, then its neck must be broken. But your sons must all be redeemed. And no one shall appear before me without a gift.

²¹ "Even during plowing and harvest times, work only six days, and rest on the seventh.

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²² "And you must remember to celebrate these three annual religious festivals: the Festival of Weeks, the Festival of the First Wheat, and the Harvest Festival.²³ On each of these three occasions all the men and boys of Israel shall appear before Yahweh.²⁴ No one will attack and conquer your land when you go up to appear before Yahweh your God those three times each year. For I will drive out the nations from before you and enlarge your boundaries.

²⁵ "You must not use leavened bread with your sacrifices to me, and none of the meat of the Passover lamb may be kept over until the following morning. ²⁶ And you must bring the best of the first of each year's crop to the Tabernacle of Yahweh your God. You must not cook a young goat in its mother's milk."

²⁷ And Yahweh said to Moses, "Write down these laws^[f] that I have given you, for they represent the terms of my covenant with you and with Israel."

²⁸ Moses was up on the mountain with Yahweh for forty days and forty nights, and in all that time he neither ate nor drank. At that time Yahweh^[g] wrote out the Covenant—the Ten Commandments—on the stone tablets.

²⁹ Moses didn't realize as he came back down the mountain with the tablets that his face glowed from being in the presence of Yahweh. ³⁰ Because of this radiance upon his face, Aaron and the people of Israel were afraid to come near him.

³¹ But Moses called them over to him, and Aaron and the leaders of the congregation came and talked with him. ³² Afterwards, all the people came to him, and he gave them the commandments Yahweh had given him upon the mountain. ³³ When Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face;^{[h] 34} but whenever he went into the Tabernacle to speak with Yahweh, he removed the veil until he came out again; then he would pass on to the people whatever instructions Yah had given him, ³⁵ and the people would see his face aglow. Afterwards he would put the veil on again until he returned to speak with Yahweh.

- a. Exodus 34:5 announced the meaning of his name, literally, "proclaimed the name of Yahweh."
- b. <u>Exodus 34:7</u> forgiving their sins, literally, "forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin." or else, implied.
- c. <u>Exodus 34:13</u> *shameful idols,* or *Asherim.* They were carved statues of male and female genital organs.
- d. <u>Exodus 34:15</u> they are spiritual prostitutes . . . sacrificing to their gods, literally, "they play the harlot worshiping their gods."
- e. <u>Exodus 34:19</u> Every firstborn male, literally, "All that opens the womb."
- f. Exodus 34:27 Write down these laws, that is, the preceding laws in vv. 12-26.
- g. Exodus 34:28 At that time God, implied; see 34:1; Deuteronomy 10:1-4.

Zechariah 1:21

Then said I, What come these to do? And he spoke, saying, These are the horns which have **scattered** Judah, so that no man did lift up his head: but these are come to fray them, to cast out the horns (*Leaders or power*) of the **Gentiles**, which lifted up their horn over the land of Judah to scatter it.

Ezekiel 36:19

And I **scattered** them among the **heathen**, and they were dispersed through the countries: according to their way and <u>according to their doings</u> I judged them.

Ezekiel 11:16

Therefore say, This says Yahweh God; Although <u>I have cast them far off among the heathen</u>, and although I have scattered them among the countries, yet will I be to them as a little sanctuary in the countries where they shall come.

Ezekiel 20:41

I will accept you with your sweet savour, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein you have been **scattered**; and I will be sanctified in you before the **heathen**.

Ezekiel 28:25

This says Yahweh God; When I shall have gathered the house of Israel from the people among whom they are **scattered**, and shall be sanctified in them in the sight of the **heathen**, then shall they dwell in their land that I have given to my servant Jacob.

Isaiah 33:3

At the noise of the tumult the people fled; at the lifting up of thyself the **nations** were **scattered**.

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Jeremiah 30:11

For I am with thee, says Yahweh, to save you: though I make a full end of all **nations** whither I have **scattered** you, yet I will not make a full end of you: but I will correct you in measure, and will not leave you altogether unpunished.

Jeremiah 31:10

Hear the word of Yahweh, O ye **nations**, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He that **scattered** Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd doth his flock.

Ezekiel 6:8

Yet will I leave a remnant, that you may have some that shall escape the sword among the **nations**, when you shall be **scattered** through the countries.

Joel 3:2

I will also gather all **nations**, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have **scattered** among the **nations**, and parted my land.

Habakkuk 3:6

He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove as under the **nations**; and the everlasting mountains were **scattered**, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways are everlasting.

Zechariah 7:14

But I **scattered** them with a whirlwind among all the **nations** whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

Blessings from Yahweh (YHWH)

1 Carefully obey *Yahweh* your *Elohim*, and faithfully follow all his commands that I'm giving you today. If you do, *Yahweh* your *Elohim* will place you high above all the other nations in the world. ² These are all the blessings that will come to you and stay close to you because you obey *Yahweh* your *Elohim*:

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³ You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country.

⁴ You will be blessed. You will have children. Your land will have crops. Your animals will have offspring. Your cattle will have calves, and your flocks will have lambs and kids.

⁵ The grain you harvest and the bread you bake will be blessed.

⁶ You will be blessed when you come and blessed when you go.

⁷ *Yahweh* will defeat your enemies when they attack you. They will attack you from one direction but run away from you in seven directions.

⁸ *Yahweh* will bless your barns and everything you do. *Yahweh* your *Elohim* will bless you in the land that he is giving you.

⁹ You will be *Yahweh's* holy people, as he promised you with an oath. He will do this if you obey the commands of *Yahweh* your *Elohim* and follow his directions. ¹⁰ Then all the people in the world will see that you are *Yahweh's* people, and they will be afraid of you. ¹¹ *Yahweh* will give you plenty of blessings: You will have many children. Your animals will have many offspring. Your soil will produce many crops in the land *Yahweh* will give you, as he swore to your ancestors.

¹² *Yahweh* will open the heavens, his rich storehouse, for you. He will send rain on your land at the right time and bless everything you do. You will be able to make loans to many nations but won't need to borrow from any. ¹³ *Yahweh* will make you the head, not the tail. You will always be at the top, never at the bottom, if you faithfully obey the commands of *Yahweh* your *Elohim* that I am giving you today. ¹⁴ Do everything I'm commanding you today. Never worship other gods or serve them.

Curses from YHWH

¹⁵ Obey *Yahweh* your *Elohim*, and faithfully follow all his commands and laws that I am giving you today. If you don't, all these curses will come to you and stay close to you:

¹⁶ You will be cursed in the city and cursed in the country.

¹⁷ The grain you harvest and the bread you bake will be cursed.

¹⁸ You will be cursed. You will have few children. Your land will have few crops. Your cattle will be cursed with few calves, and your flocks will have few lambs and kids.

¹⁹ You will be cursed when you come and cursed when you go.

²⁰ *Yahweh* will send you curses, panic, and frustration in everything you do until you're destroyed and quickly disappear for the evil you will do by abandoning *Yahweh*. ²¹ *Yahweh* will send one plague after another on you until he wipes you out of the land you're about to enter and

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take possession of. ²² *Yahweh* will strike you with disease, fever, and inflammation; heat waves, ^[a] drought, ^[b] scorching winds, ^[c] and ruined crops. They will pursue you until you die. ²³ The sky above will look like bronze, and the ground below will be as hard as iron. ²⁴ *Yahweh* will send dust storms and sandstorms on you from the sky until you're destroyed.

²⁵ *Yahweh* will let your enemies defeat you. You will attack them from one direction but run away from them in seven directions. You will become a thing of horror to all the kingdoms in the world. ²⁶ Your dead bodies will be food for all the birds and wild animals. There will be no one to scare them away. ²⁷ *Yahweh* will strike you with the same boils that plagued the Egyptians. He will strike you with hemorrhoids, ^[d] sores, ^[e] and itching^[f] that won't go away. ²⁸ *Yahweh* will strike you with madness, blindness, and panic. ²⁹ You will grope in broad daylight as blind people grope in their blindness. You won't be successful in anything you do.^[g] As long as you live, you will be oppressed and robbed with no one to rescue you.

³⁰ You will be engaged to a woman, but another man will have sex with her. You will build a house, but you won't live in it. You will plant a vineyard, but you won't enjoy the grapes.
³¹ Your ox will be butchered as you watch, but you won't eat any of its meat. You will watch as your donkey is stolen from you, but you'll never get it back. Your flock will be given to your enemies, and no one will rescue it. ³² You will watch with your own eyes as your sons and daughters are given to another nation. You will strain your eyes looking for them all day long, but there will be nothing you can do. ³³ People you never knew will eat what your land and your hard work have produced. As long as you live, you will know nothing but oppression and abuse.
³⁴ The things you see will drive you mad. ³⁵ Yahweh will afflict your knees and legs with severe boils that can't be cured. The boils will cover your whole body from the soles of your feet to the top of your head.

³⁶ *Yahweh* will lead you and the king you choose to a nation that you and your ancestors never knew. There you will worship gods made of wood and stone. ³⁷ You will become a thing of horror. All the nations where *Yahweh* will send you will make an example of you and ridicule you.

³⁸ You will plant many crops in your fields, but harvest little because locusts will destroy your crops. ³⁹ You will plant vineyards and take care of them, but you won't drink any wine or gather any grapes, because worms will eat them. ⁴⁰ You will have olive trees everywhere in your country but no olive oil to rub on your skin, because the olives will fall off the trees. ⁴¹ You will have sons and daughters, but you won't be able to keep them because they will be taken as prisoners of war. ⁴² Crickets will swarm all over your trees and the crops in your fields.

⁴³ The standard of living for the foreigners who live among you will rise higher and higher, while your standard of living will sink lower and lower. ⁴⁴ They will be able to make loans to you, but you won't be able to make loans to them. They will be the head, and you will be the tail.

⁴⁵ All these curses will come to you. They will pursue you and stay close to you until you're destroyed, because you didn't obey *Yahweh* your *Elohim* or follow his commands and laws, which I'm giving you. ⁴⁶ These curses will be a sign and an amazing thing to warn you and your descendants forever. ⁴⁷ You didn't serve *Yahweh* your *Elohim* with a joyful and happy heart

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when you had so much. ⁴⁸ So you will serve your enemies, whom *Yahweh* will send against you. You will serve them even though you are already hungry, thirsty, naked, and in need of everything. *Yahweh* will put a heavy burden of hard work on you until he destroys you.

⁴⁹ *Yahweh* will bring against you a nation from far away, from the ends of the earth. The nation will swoop down on you like an eagle. It will be a nation whose language you won't understand. ⁵⁰ Its people will be fierce-looking. They will show no respect for the old and no pity for the young. ⁵¹ They'll eat the offspring of your animals and the crops from your fields until you're destroyed. They'll leave you no grain, no new wine, no olive oil, no calves from your herds, and no lambs or kids from your flocks. They'll continue to do this until they've completely ruined you. ⁵² They will blockade all your cities until the high, fortified walls in which you trust come down everywhere in your land. They'll blockade all the cities everywhere in the land that *Yahweh* your *Elohim* is giving you.

⁵³ Because of the hardships your enemies will make you suffer during the blockade, you will eat the flesh of your own children, the sons and daughters, whom *Yahweh* your *Elohim* has given you. ⁵⁴ Even the most tender and sensitive man among you will become stingy toward his brother, the wife he loves, and the children he still has left. ⁵⁵ He will give none of them any of the flesh of his children that he is eating. It will be all that he has left, because of the hardships your enemies will make you suffer during the blockade of all your cities. ⁵⁶ The most tender and sensitive woman among you—so sensitive and tender that she wouldn't even step on an ant will become stingy toward the husband she loves or toward her own son or daughter. ⁵⁷ She won't share with them the afterbirth from her body and the children she gives birth to. She will secretly eat them out of dire necessity, because of the hardships your enemies will make you suffer during the blockade of your cities.

⁵⁸ You might not faithfully obey every word of the teachings that are written in this book. You might not fear this glorious and awe-inspiring name: *Yahweh* your *Elohim*. ⁵⁹ If so, *Yahweh* will strike you and your descendants with unimaginable plagues. They will be terrible and continuing plagues and severe and lingering diseases. ⁶⁰ He will again bring all the diseases of Egypt that you dreaded, and they will cling to you. ⁶¹ *Yahweh* will also bring you every kind of sickness and plague not written in this Book of Teachings. They will continue until you're dead. ⁶² At one time you were as numerous as the stars in the sky. But only a few of you will be left, because you didn't obey *Yahweh* your *Elohim*. ⁶³ At one time *Yahweh* was more than glad to make you prosperous and numerous. Now *Yahweh* will be more than glad to destroy you and wipe you out. You will be torn out of the land you're about to enter and take possession of.

⁶⁴ Then *Yahweh* will scatter you among all the people of the world, from one end of the earth to the other. There you will serve gods made of wood and stone that neither you nor your ancestors ever knew. ⁶⁵ Among those nations you will find no peace, no place to call your own. There *Yahweh* will give you an unsettled mind, failing eyesight, and despair. ⁶⁶ Your life will always be hanging by a thread. You will live in terror day and night. You will never feel sure of your life. ⁶⁷ In the morning you'll say, "If only it were evening!" And in the evening you'll say, "If only it were morning!" You'll talk this way because of the things that will terrify you and because of the things you'll see. ⁶⁸ *Yahweh* will bring you back to Egypt in ships^[h] on a journey that I said you

would never take again. There you will try to sell yourselves as slaves to your enemies, but no one will buy you.

I WILL ATTEMPT TO SHOW FROM THE BIBLE WHERE SOME HEBREWS STATE THEY'RE **BLACK** IN COLOR.

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LAMENTATIONS 5:10

JEREMIAH THE PROPHET IS TALKING ABOUT THE SUFFERING OF BLACK HEBREWS, HE STATES:

GENESIS 15:11-16

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The Tetragrammaton

The covenantal name of God in the Hebrew Bible is written with the four consonants: Yodh He Waw He. This name is known as the Tetragrammaton (Greek for "the four letters"). Although the Tetragrammaton was pronounced freely at the time the Torah and Prophets were written, its holiness in Judaism is such that it is no longer pronounced, except under very rare circumstances. In order to avoid offending religious Jews, one should not pronounce or misuse this name.

Stringent rules also apply to writing any of the names of God. For example, once God's name is written it is to be neither erased nor discarded. It must be stored. This is why you see circumlocutions like "G-d," which do not need to be kept. (<u>Recent rulings</u> indicate that use in computer files or displays does not constitute erasing.)

Most English translations of the Bible represent the Tetragrammaton with "LORD" or "GOD" in all capital letters.

in the consonantal Hebrew text:



YHWH

These are the four consonants: Hebrew to the left, and Roman transliteration to the right. Capital letters correspond to the consonants of the Hebrew.

as traditionally pronounced:



'aDoNaY

When one reads the Hebrew Bible, it is traditional to pronounce the word "Adonay" instead of pronouncing the Tetragrammaton. "Adonay" means "my Lord" (except that Lord is plural, in deference to the majesty of God).

In many traditional circles in the contemporary world, the circumlocution Adonay is no longer used, except in religious uses such as prayer. In uses such as study, one will instead hear "Ado-shem," a combination of Adonay and Shem ("name"). Another circumlocution is Ha-Shem ("the Name"). There are also written circumlocutions.

as represented in the Masoretic pointed text:



In the Masoretic text, the Tetragrammaton is written with the vowels of "Adonay" to remind the reader to pronounce "Adonay" instead of the Tetragrammaton. A Christian scribe of the Middle Ages misunderstood this convention and transcribed the combination into Latin as "Jehovah," as if this were the name of God. This confused form entered English usage in several translations of the Bible.

short forms:

The Hebrew Bible and other Hebrew literature uses several shortened forms of the Tetragrammaton. These forms can be pronounced without offence. Indeed, they are parts of relatively common words.



the presumed original pronunciation:

Based on philology and representations in ancient languages such as Greek (see below), most scholars consider this the original pronunciation of the Tetragrammaton. This form has been used in Christian translations such as the Jerusalem Bible.

old Hebrew script:

YHWH

The tetragrammaton is written in several ancient Hebrew and Greek manuscripts using this old Hebrew script.



Greek manuscripts of the Jewish scriptures and Greek magical texts represent the Tetragrammaton is several ways. The examples above include an attempt to mimic the Hebrew letters with Greek and two transliterations. Old Hebrew is used in a couple of old manuscripts. Another common approach is to use the Greek word Kyrios, "Lord." Occasionally, we find "Adonai" in Greek.

The enemies of the Israelites divided their land between themselves, and have kept it that way unto this very day. The Bible calls it "Cast Lots." This is what we did when we first entered the land as shown below, but when we were conquered the enemies of the Israelites did the same thing. The first example shows us doing it, then the Gentiles and others followed suit.

The Last of the Land Is Divided (By the Israelites)

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How did other nations make the claim to be the chosen people?

2 Kings 17 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

1 In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years. ² And he did *that which was* evil in the sight of Yahweh, but not as the kings of Israel that were before him. ³ Against him came up Shalmaneser king of Assyria; and Hoshea became his servant, and gave him presents.

⁴ And the king of Assyria found conspiracy in Hoshea: for he had sent messengers to So king of Egypt, and brought no present to the king of Assyria, as *he had done* year by year: therefore the king of Assyria shut him up, and bound him in prison. ⁵ Then the king of Assyria came up throughout all the land, and went up to Samaria, and besieged it three years. ⁶ In the ninth year of Hoshea the king of Assyria took Samaria, and carried Israel away into Assyria, and placed them in Halah and in Habor *by* the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.

⁷ For *so* it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against Yahweh their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods, ⁸ and walked in the statutes of the heathen, whom Yahweh cast out from before the children of Israel, and of the kings of Israel, which they had made. ⁹ And the children of Israel did secretly *those* things that *were* not right against Yahweh their God, and they built them high places in all their cities, from the tower of the watchmen to the fenced city. ¹⁰ And they set them up images and groves in every high hill, and under every green tree: ¹¹ and there they burnt incense in all the high places, as *did* the heathen whom Yahweh carried away before them; and wrought wicked things to provoke Yahweh to anger:

¹² for they served idols, whereof Yahweh had said unto them, You shall not do this thing. ¹³ Yet Yahweh testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, *and by* all the seers, saying, Turn you from your evil ways, and keep my commandments *and* my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets. ¹⁴ Notwithstanding they would not hear, but hardened their necks, like to the neck of their fathers, that did not believe in Yahweh their God.

¹⁵ And they rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his testimonies which he testified against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that *were* round about them, *concerning* whom Yahweh had charged them, that they should not do like them. ¹⁶ And they left all the commandments of Yahweh their God, and made them molten images, *even* two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal. ¹⁷ And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of Yahweh, to provoke him to anger.

²² For the children of Israel walked in all the sins of Jeroboam which he did; they departed not from them; ²³ until Yahweh removed Israel out of his sight, as he had said by all his servants the prophets. So was Israel carried away out of their own land to Assyria unto this day.

²⁴ And the king of Assyria brought *men* from Babylon, and from Cuthah, and from Ava, and from Hamath, and from Sepharvaim, and placed *them* in the cities of Samaria instead of the children of Israel: and they possessed Samaria, and dwelt in the cities thereof. ²⁵ And *so* it was at the beginning of their dwelling there, *that* they feared not Yahweh: therefore Yahweh sent lions among them, which slew *some* of them. ²⁶ Wherefore they spoke to the king of Assyria, saying, The nations which you have removed, and placed in the cities of Samaria, know not the manner of the God of the land: therefore he have sent lions among them, and, behold, they slay them, because they know not the manner of the God of the land.

²⁷ Then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, Carry thither one of the priests whom you brought from there; and let them go and dwell there, and let him teach them the manner of the God of the land.

²⁸Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Beth-el, and taught them how they should fear Yahweh.

²⁹ Howbeit every nation made gods of their own, and put *them* in the houses of the high places which the Samaritans had made, every nation in their cities wherein they dwelt. ³⁰ And the men of Babylon made Succoth-benoth, and the men of Cuth made Nergal, and the men of Hamath made Ashima, ³¹ and the Avites made Nibhaz and Tartak, and the Sepharvites burnt their children in fire to Adrammelech and Anammelech, the gods of Sepharvaim.

³² So they feared Yahweh, and made unto themselves of the lowest of them priests of the high places, which sacrificed for them in the houses of the high places.

³³They feared Yahweh, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from there.

³⁴ Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not Yahweh, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which Yahweh commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel; ³⁵ with whom Yahweh had made a covenant, and charged them, saying, You shall not fear other gods, nor bow yourselves to them, nor serve them, nor sacrifice to them: ³⁶ but Yahweh, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt with great power and a stretched out arm, him shall you fear, and him shall you worship, and to him shall you do sacrifice.

³⁷ And the statutes, and the ordinances, and the law, and the commandment, which he wrote for you, you shall observe to do for evermore; and you shall not fear other gods. ³⁸ And the covenant that I have made with you shall you not forget; neither shall you fear other gods. ³⁹ But Yahweh your God you shall fear; and he shall deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies.

⁴⁰Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner.

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⁴¹ So these nations feared Yahweh, and served their graven images, both their children, and their children's children: as did their fathers, so do they unto this day.

2 Kings 17 Living Bible (TLB)

¹⁻² New king of Israel: Hoshea

Father's name: Elah

Length of reign: 9 years, in Samaria

Character of his reign: evil-but not as bad as some of the other kings of Israel

Reigning in Judah at that time: King Ahaz, who had been the king there for 12 years

³ King Shalmaneser of Assyria attacked and defeated King Hoshea, so Israel had to pay heavy annual taxes to Assyria. ⁴ Then Hoshea conspired against the king of Assyria by asking King So of Egypt to help him shake free of Assyria's power, but this treachery was discovered. At the same time he refused to pay the annual tribute to Assyria. So the king of Assyria put him in prison and in chains for his rebellion.

⁵ Now the land of Israel was filled with Assyrian troops for three years besieging Samaria, the capital city of Israel. ⁶ Finally, in the ninth year of King Hoshea's reign, Samaria fell and the people of Israel were exiled to Assyria. They were placed in colonies in the city of Halah and along the banks of the Habor River in Gozan, and among the cities of the Medes.

⁷ This disaster came upon the nation of Israel because the people worshiped other gods, thus sinning against Yahweh their God who had brought them safely out of their slavery in Egypt. ⁸ They had followed the evil customs of the nations which Yahweh had cast out from before them. ⁹ The people of Israel had also secretly done many things that were wrong, and they had built altars to other gods throughout the land.^{[a] 10} They had placed obelisks and idols at the top of every hill and under every green tree; ¹¹ and they had burned incense to the gods of the very nations which Yahweh had cleared out of the land when Israel came in. So the people of Israel had done many evil things, and Yahweh was very angry. ¹² Yes, they worshiped idols, despite Yahweh's specific and repeated warnings.

¹³ Again and again Yahweh had sent prophets to warn both Israel and Judah to turn from their evil ways; he had warned them to obey his commandments which he had given to their ancestors through these prophets, ¹⁴ but Israel wouldn't listen. The people were as stubborn as their ancestors and refused to believe in Yahweh their God. ¹⁵ They rejected his laws and the covenant he had made with their ancestors, and despised all his warnings. In their foolishness they worshiped heathen idols despite Yahweh's stern warnings. ¹⁶ They defied all the commandments of Yahweh their God and made two calves from molten gold. They made detestable, shameful idols and worshiped Baal and the sun, moon, and stars. ¹⁷ They even burned their own sons and daughters to death on the altars of Molech; they consulted fortune-tellers and used magic and sold themselves to evil. So Yahweh was very angry. ¹⁸ He swept them from his sight until only the tribe of Judah remained in the land.

¹⁹ But even Judah refused to obey the commandments of Yahweh their God; they too walked in the same evil paths as Israel had. ²⁰ So Yahweh rejected all the descendants of Jacob. ^[b] He punished them by delivering them to their attackers until they were destroyed. ²¹ For Israel split off from the kingdom of David and chose Jeroboam I (the son of Nebat) as its king. Then Jeroboam drew Israel away from following Yahweh. He made them sin a great sin, ²² and the people of Israel never quit doing the evil things that Jeroboam led them into, ²³ until Yahweh finally swept them away, just as all his prophets had warned would happen. So Israel was carried off to the land of Assyria where they remain to this day.

²⁴ And the king of Assyria transported colonies of people from Babylon, Cuthah, Avva, Hamath, and Sepharvaim and resettled them in the cities of Samaria, replacing the people of Israel. So the Assyrians took over Samaria and the other cities of Israel. ²⁵ But since these Assyrian colonists did not worship Yahweh when they first arrived, Yahweh sent lions among them to kill some of them.

²⁶ Then they sent a message to the king of Assyria: "We colonists here in Israel don't know the laws of the god of the land, and he has sent lions among us to destroy us because we have not worshiped him."

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²⁷⁻²⁸ The king of Assyria then decreed that one of the exiled priests from Samaria should return to Israel and teach the new residents the laws of the god of the land. So one of them returned to Bethel and taught the colonists from Babylon how to worship Yahweh.

²⁹ But these foreigners also worshiped their own gods. They placed them in the shrines on the hills near their cities. ³⁰ Those from Babylon worshiped idols of their god Succoth-benoth; those from Cuth worshiped their god Nergal; and the men of Hamath worshiped Ashima. ³¹ The gods Nibhaz and Tartak were worshiped by the Avvites, and the people from Sephar even burned their own children on the altars of their gods Adrammelech and Anammelech.

³² They also worshiped Yahweh, and they appointed from among themselves priests to sacrifice to Yahweh on the hilltop altars. ³³ But they continued to follow the religious customs of the nations from which they came. ³⁴ And this is still going on among them today—they follow their former practices instead of truly worshiping Yahweh or obeying the laws he gave to the descendants of Jacob (whose name was later changed to Israel). ³⁵⁻³⁶ For Yahweh had made a contract with them—that they were never to worship or make sacrifices to any heathen gods. They were to worship only Yahweh who had brought them out of the land of Egypt with such tremendous miracles and power. ³⁷ The descendants of Jacob were to obey all of God's laws and *never* worship other gods.

³⁸ For God had said, "You must never forget the covenant I made with you; never worship other gods. ³⁹ You must worship only Yahweh; he will save you from all your enemies."

⁴⁰ But Israel didn't listen, and the people continued to worship other gods. ⁴¹ These colonists from Babylon worshiped Yahweh, yes—but they also worshiped their idols. And to this day their descendants do the same thing.

Who Was Abraham's Mother?

The name of Abraham's mother is not mentioned in the Bible. Not only does she remain nameless, but her very existence is only hinted at in the Torah. She does not appear during the story of Abraham's birth (Genesis 11.26), but is mentioned only when Abraham explains to Abimelech, king of Gerar, that Sarah is his sister from his father's side but not from his mother's side (Genesis 20.12).

The Sages of the Talmud record that her name was Amathlai, the daughter of Karnebo, and that she became the wife of Terah, Abraham's father. We do not know how the Sages knew her name, but when they recorded it they also supplied the names of the mother of David, Samson, and Haman. Haman's mother is mentioned only because her name is also Amathlai, identical with the name of Abraham's mother. More interesting is their reason for reporting the names of the other three mothers. The Sages said that the reason they provided these names was to make this information available to those who engage in debates with the *minim* or sectarians [TB Baba Batra 91a]. This may have been a reference to the debates that the Talmudic Sages had with the early Christians who were their contemporaries. It is also possible that naming the mother of these "founders" of the Jewish religion was meant to counter the Christian argument of the immaculate conception of the Nazarene.

Who was Amathlai and what is known about her? Though ignored in the Torah, one Midrashic legend relates that Amathlai became pregnant with Abraham at the very time that Nimrod learned that a boy would be born soon and this boy would successfully rise up against him. After consulting with his princes he ordered the construction of a special compound where all pregnant women were commanded to remain until after they had given birth. He also ordered his midwives to kill all male infants that were born in the special compounds, but to give many presents to all newborn girls. In this way no less than seventy thousand boys were said to have been murdered.

When Amathlai was three months pregnant Terah, her husband, noticed that she was very pale and that her body was growing bigger. She desperately wanted to avoid going to the special compound, so she told her husband that she was not feeling well. But Terah, a loyal subject of King Nimrod, reminded her that she must follow the king's command and report to the special compound if she was pregnant. Since he was

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still suspicious, he insisted on examining her, but a miracle occurred when his hands passed over her body. He did not feel anything because the embryo rose from Amathlai's womb until it lay beneath her breasts. Terah now permitted her stay at home. Inexplicably her body did not grow any bigger during the last six months of pregnancy. No one, not even her husband, became suspicious that she was pregnant. When the time came for giving birth, she disappeared from the city and wandered alone into the desert. There she found a cave where she gave birth to a son whom she names Abram. However she was very sad because she was certain that sooner or later Nimrod's agents would seize the boy and kill him. In desperation she decided to abandon her baby in the cave and leave him in God's care. Miraculously the angel Gabriel saved the baby boy.

Tradition presents Amathlai as a very brave woman, ready to defy her husband and her king in order to save her unborn child. She receives ongoing Divine help in these efforts. But at the crucial moment, after the birth of her son, she loses hope and abandons him. Now Abraham's survival no longer depends on his mother's efforts. Instead God's wish to have Abraham become the patriarch of the [*Hebrew*] people becomes the motivation for Divine intervention. In later years Abraham rises to greatness but his mother who abandoned him as an infant is not present to witness this. No more is heard of her.
