WORDS OF REMEMBERING (Isaiah 58: 1-12)

We remember that Jesus quoted Isaiah throughout the gospels – for Christ came to lead followers who feed those who are hungry, sheltered those unhoused, clothed those naked and comfort those afflicted. Christ came to lead followers to destroy followers to destroy injustices, lift up those who are oppressed, break the yokes of those victimized and, at the same time, stop pointing fingers of blame. And we remember that Jesus sealed the covenant not in a fast of deprivation, but a feast of hope, sitting at a seder celebrating escape from oppression, and claiming that the new Way is bread and fruit and love.
