MANY: MERCIFUL GOD, WHEN WE LOOK AROUND, THE PROMISES OF YOUR KINGDOM SEEM SO DISTANT.

One: Grant us tenacity:

MANY: TO BRING LIGHT WHERE THERE IS DARKNESS; PEACE WHERE THERE IS STRIFE, COMFORT WHERE THERE IS DESPAIR.

ALL: LET THE LIGHT OF YOUR PRESENCE SHINE IN US,
