



- 1. Susan led a prayer.
- 2. **May minutes** were read and approved. Bonnie Hanrahan as agreed to be on the Endowment Committee. LouAnn/Lucy
- 3. **May financial reports** were discussed. Rachel will be asked if undated envelopes can be purchased for next year. The cost of stamps will be going up in August so Connie will purchase some at the current price to use this fall for stewardship. Reports approved. Charmaine/Cheryl
- 4. **Pastors** have been reserved for services through the end of July. Judy Nell will be asked to do a **greeters list** beginning in July and have it puublished in Chapel Bells.
- 5. The council has met with another **interim pastor** and will meet again with her to discuss finances on June 21.
- 6. A **search committee has been formed** and will soon meet with Rev. Lorraine from the Association to begin their work. Members are: Steve Manuell, Brett Miller, Cindy Cain, Peggy Ahles, Tom Pahnke, Debra Weber, and Betty Zimpelman
- 7. The **projector** had not been repaired yet.

- 9. The process of **repairing the steeple cross** has begun with measurments taken using a bucket lift. Installation of the LED cross should be completed in a few weeks. Jack hopes to be able to repair the hole in the shingles at the same time as the installation. Locating a steeple roofer is proving challenging.
- 10. The **Ladies Guild has had updated church brochures** printed. The council would like them to continue handing out to new families in the area and will support them at this time financially for printing and stamps.
- 11. Since **recordings of the service** takes up a lot of room on the computer, they will only be saved a short time before deletion. Cheryl will turn on the computer for all future **zoom services**.
