- 1. The **meeting was called to order at 6:00** by President Susan Miller. In attendance were: Connie Johnson, Charmaine Duerhing, Lucy Krapfl, Janene Kluever, LouAnn Evert, Cheryl Fischer absent: Jess Staus
- 2. September minutes were read and approved.
- 3. September financials were discussed. **\$9,000 from Memorial Fund** has been transferred to United Church Funds. Cost of **parking lot lights** will be looked into. Possibly changing to LED lights to save money. **Envelope giving** is above budget at this time. Report approved.
- 4. Pastor Bev Davis joined the meeting via face time and gave her Pastor's report. There will be a baptism on December 5 for Clara Becker, infant daughter of Chelsea and Adam Becker. All Saint's Day will be observed on October 31. Pastor Bev will contact Donna about sending out an email for names of deceased persons to be remembered on that day. Pew cards for joys and concerns are being made. Lack of Pastoral Care was discussed and should start soon. A list of needs has been given to Pastor Bev.
- 5. The Sunday School Christmas Pageant will be on December 19. Christmas Eve Services will be at 4:30 and 6:30.

- Liason reports: Building and Grounds the steeple is too tall for the Amish to reshingle. It is temporarily patched and we will continue to look for a contractor. PPRC Blondie's cleaning duties were discussed. Garbage in the kitchen has been an issue. This will be monitored.
