


A special thanks to all of you for your prayers, get well wishes, calls, flowers, food and the many cards which always lifted my spirits.

1. Opening Prayer

- **2. Review and Approval of October Minutes** The October 2020 minutes were reviewed and approved with two corrections. Adam moved and Curt seconded.
- **3.** Review and Approval of October Financials The October 2020 financials were reviewed and unanimously approved. Lou Ann moved, Lucy seconded.

1. Opening Prayer

- **2. Review and Approval of November Minutes** The November 2020 minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved with one correction re: openings on Council. There will be two openings on Council; the President is appointed by the Council. Curt moved, LouAnn seconded.
- **3. Review and Approval of November Financials** The November 2020 financials were reviewed and unanimously approved. Lucy moved, Adam seconded.
- **4. Pastor's Report** A written report presented and reviewed with Council. A request was made and unanimously approved for vacation from December 27, 2020 to January 3, 2021. Adam moved, Jill seconded.
- **5.** Discussion of Personnel Committee's Recommendation to Buy Out One Week of Pastor Glenn's Vacation Discussion was held. A motion was made by Curt and seconded by Sue to accept the Personnel Committee's recommendation to buy out one week of Pastor Glenn's vacation. NOTE: It was believed at the time that the vote passed with four (4) members in favor and three (3) opposed. It was later discovered that the vote was heard incorrectly and that three (3) members were in favor and four (4) opposed. This matter was raised and addressed at the council meeting on January 11, 2021.
- **6.** Discussion of Personnel Committee's Recommendation for a Partial Pay Program for Jill Lotzow, Accompanist, During Virtual Worship Discussion was held. Partial payment to Jill Lotzow was unanimously approved. Adam moved, Lucy seconded.
- 7. Preliminary Budget Discussion This matter was tabled until the January 2020 meeting.
- **8.** Church Closing Status Discussion was held; a motion and second was made to reopen the Church beginning December 20th while continuing to offer the Zoom option. Adam moved, Lucy seconded. The motion passed with a vote of 6 to 1.
- 9. Distribution of Offering Envelopes Discussion was held. No decision was made.
- **10. Finalize Membership Review** The Council moved into closed session; Adam moved, Cheryl seconded. After discussion the Council moved back into open session; Adam moved, Jill seconded.
- **11. Nominating Committee Update** Recommendations were received for two members to Council and two members to the Endowment Committee.
- **12**. **Liaison Reports** The Women's Guild has made all of their donations for the 2021 budget. The church will use the same snowplowing service as last year. There was no further update on the steeple and cross repair.

- **13. Review Church Closing & Call Tree Notification** The Council reviewed the call tree assignments in the event of church closing. Posting of church closing information will remain the same.
- **14. Set Date for Annual Meeting** A date February 7, 2021 for the annual meeting was unanimously approved. Adam moved, LouAnn seconded.
- 11. Set Council Meeting Date The next meeting will be January 11, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.
