



Bridge pastor John Helt began the meeting with a prayer

February 15 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved. Janene/Jess -passes

Susan made a motion to nominate Connie Johnson to continue as **treasurer**. Seconded by LouAnn - passed.

February financial reports were discussed and approved. Charmaine/Cheryl-passed

Pastors report by new Bridge Pastor, John Helt. Easter services were discussed. See discussion below. He will ask for more members for caregiving team.

Committee lists for 2021 were updated. Charmaine will redo and distribute via email for next meeting.

Committee liasons were assigned as follows:

Proposed building and grounds pojects for 2021 were reviewed – clean up lightning rods near rooster door, washing of church siding by outside company, replacing of sign room door, refinishing of church pews using volunteers, and repair of lighted cross using insurance money received earlier. 
Serving of coffee in fellowship hall after services was discussed. At this time, decided to wait until after Easter to see how in person worship is working out and more members are vaccinated.
