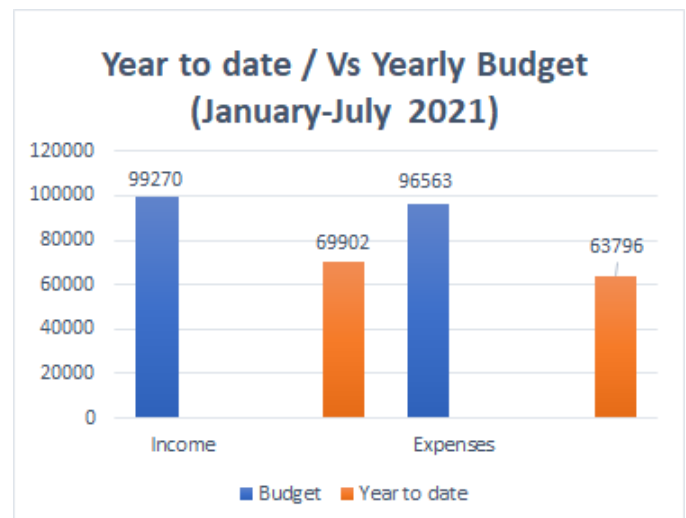

July 12, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:00. Susan Miller, Charmaine Duehring, LouAnn Evert, Lucy Krapfl, Cheryl Fischer, Connie Johnson and Janene Kluever were in attendance. Jess Staus was absent.

1. Susan led a **prayer** to open the meeting.
2. **June minutes** were a read and approved. Cheryl/Janene
3. **June financials** were discussed. Amounts not covered by insurance for the **bell repair** should come from memorial funds. Janene is still looking into **internet costs**. Approved Lucy/ LouAnn
4. **Pulpit supply** has been secured through August and for second Sunday in September. Pastor Bev will be returning her contract soon.
5. The **Search Committee will be commissioned** on Sunday, July 18 and meet with Rev. Lorraine Cenesaras after church to begin their job of finding a permanent pastor.
6. The **projector company** has been contacted and we are awaiting a date for them to assess.
7. **Pledge cards** will be printed by the church office and be given to the stewardship committee when they meet in fall. Rachel will be asked to print giving reports through September to be included with stewardship letters.
8. Susan will contact last years **stewardship committee** to see if they will serve again and direct them to the resoures available on the UCC website.
9. **Liason updates: Building and Grounds-** Cross has been repaired but **timer needs to be replaced** and that will be done soon. Office screen has been repaired. Fire inspection completed. **Guild-Cookie Walk** will be scheduled in December **General – Chili luncheon** will be discussed at next meeting and invitation to have dance group from Waukesha will be declined this year due to not having a permanent pastor. **Seniors** will again begin meeting in August – first Tuesday of the month.
10. **Undated envelopes** will be ordered by Rachel since many members only use one a month. Use will be evaluated next year.
11. The **membership list** was discussed and council members will reach out to a number of young adults to see if they want to be included as members now that they are on their own. Updated list will be finalized at August meeting.
12. Next council meeting will be held on August 9 at 6 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 7:10.
