Adult Services

The Library strives to provide quality programs and collections that reflect the interests of Dobbs Ferry residents. The Adult Services Department is happy to respond to reference assistance requests, book recommendations, and ideas from the community for special programs.

The Library offers monthly book discussion groups and film series:

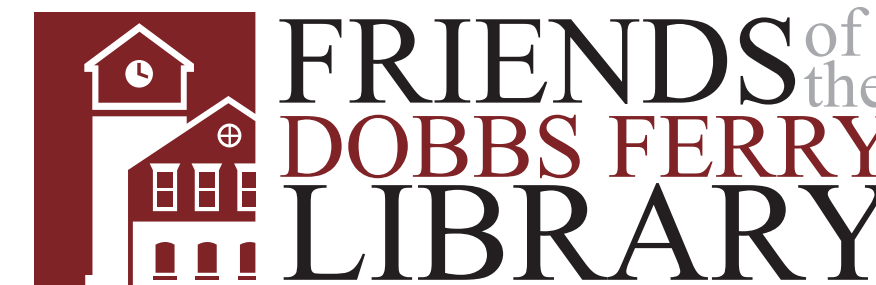

By-laws Changes

Proposed change under Article V: Officers: Section 3. Officers shall be elected by the majority vote of those **members with an active membership** of two (2) years.

No officer may serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office.

The President, whose term is just completed will be a member of the Executive Board for the following term.

Members of the Board or any Committee thereof may at any time participate in a meeting of such Board or Committee by means of conference telephone, video- conference, or similar device by which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other.

Participation in a meeting pursuant to this section shall constitute presence in person at such meeting, and votes may be cast by such means in all matters requiring a vote.
