Full Bronze Country Western Rhythm certification you must complete these dances on the journey chart. Cha Cha, Eastcoast Swing, Polka & Two Step. Full Bronze Ballroom Smooth certification you must complete these dances on the journey chart. Foxtrot, Tango, Viennese Waltz, Waltz. Full Bronze Ballroom Rhythm certification you must complete these dances on the journey chart. Bolero, Cha Cha, Eastcoast Swing, Mambo & Rumba.

Video taping and taking pictures of your friends and family is permitted.
