**Transcript Column Headings:**

**SUBJ No.:** displays the course subject prefix and number

**X:** any course beginning with X is a non-credit continuing education course.

**AV:** any course beginning with AV is an area vocational course calculated by clock hours, rather than credit hours.

Note: Effective January 2006, vocational contact hour courses were transitioned into credit hour courses with the grades counting in both the semester and cumulative GPA. Vocational courses taken prior to January 2006 will NOT be changed to credit hour courses and will remain as contact hours.

**H:** in the course number indicates that the course is an honors course.

**Course Numbering:** August 1969 to May 1975: courses were numbered 100 to 399. June 1975 to May 1984: four digit course numbers were randomly assigned. June 1984 to present: courses are numbered 100 to 299.

**CRED:** displays the credit hours for each course. All credits are recorded in semester hours.

**GRD:** displays the grade earned in each course

**PTS:** displays the quality points earned for each course

**R:** displays an "I" or "E" to show how repeated courses are calculated into GPA.

**E:** the repeated course is excluded from the semester and the cumulative GPA.

**I:** the recently repeated course is included in the semester and the cumulative GPA. The current repeat policy indicated above became effective in the summer 1995 term.
