Milestones in New Lima's History:

Organization:

- Formed and Incorporated as a 501c3 charitable organization in 2000
- First certified by the City of Lima, as a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) in 2003
- Became a State Certified CHDO in 2006

Housing Developments:

- Has occupied several roles: developer, general contractor, owner, sales agent, management company, lender & escrow agent
- Since 2003, been a developer in 7 large scale (>10 units) housing developments and 4 smaller infill housing developments
- To date, developed 318 units of affordable housing statewide with 2 additional homeownership units currently in pre-development
- Been a part of more than \$61M in affordable housing development \$41M of this has been in Lima, OH
- In 2019, received a grant of \$1M from the Federal Home Loan Bank of Cincinnati to be used towards the Spring Street Senior Lofts development

Programming:

- Partnered with the City of Lima and West Ohio Community Action Partnership (WOCAP), in 2009, to provide administrative support for the First Home Lima down payment assistance program
- Began hosting a repair and maintenance class in 2009 in conjunction with the First Home Lima program
- Supportive service provider for Spring Street Senior Lofts, Shawnee Lofts and Shirley Daley Senior Village



Whittier Place

- Developed between 2006 2012 utilizing unspent HOME dollars and promoting affordable homeownership opportunities
- New Lima purchased and subdivided the former Whittier School site into 12 individual parcels
- New Lima Housing For The Future developed 7 affordable single-family homeownership units
- Donated 5 lots to Habitat for Humanity:
 - Developed 4 single-family homes
 - Sold their final lot to one of the neighboring homes





Whittier Place: Where It All Began . . .

Whittier Place led to the founding and formation of the New Lima – Housing For The Future organization when the City of Lima had a backlog of unspent HUD grant dollars!

Several years later, in 2014 and as result of the 2008 housing crisis, the organization pioneered a seller-financed mortgage option to sell five unsold homes. The strategy gained recognition from local officials and HUD offices in Columbus and Washington, D.C., ultimately earning federal approval!

This innovative solution enabled **five households** to achieve homeownership; each now having fully paid off their homes, creating long-term stability and generational wealth!

On **November 23, 2024**; surrounded by friends, family, and representatives from both the City of Lima & New Lima Housing For The Future - The Whittier Place homeowners, **having successfully paid off their mortgages**, came together to celebrate their achievement by burning their mortgages!!!









New Lima Homes

- Developed between 2003 2005
 as a strategy to provide low-to moderate income households an
 alternate path to homeownership
- 60 Single-Family Homes developed
- 3 of these homes were sold, to current residents, in 2020. 57 of these homes remain as affordable rentals.
- Funding sources:
 - Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC)
 - HOME Investment Partnership Program
 - Housing Development Gap Financing













Shirley Daley Senior Village

- Our "Flagship" community with 24-affordable rentals for seniors age 62+, with incomes at or below 50% of the area median income level
- Developed in partnership with WSOS and the City of Lima in 2012
- Funding sources included:
 - Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP 1 & 2) Funds
 - Local HOME Investment Partnership Program
 - State HOME funds

Fourteen years later, Shirley Daley Senior Village continues to thrive, with demand so strong that the waitlist exceeds two years! Expanding access to additional affordable senior housing remains a key goal for New Lima – Housing For The Future.

A Community Rooted in Legacy...

Shirley Daley Senior Village honors former Lima City Council member Shirley J. Daley, a fierce advocate for equity, inclusion, and community progress!



The Shirley Daley Community Fund purchased the vacated Lowell School site when New Lima was just beginning and lacked resources. Once able to, New Lima purchased the land back from the Shirley Daley Community Fund and went on to develop the site into the vibrant, community it is today! A lasting symbol of partnership, vision, and impact!

A roadway within the community, named **Charles Daley Way**, honors Charles Daley; New Lima's former attorney and husband of Shirley J. Daley, for his pivotal role and dedication in the formation of New Lima – Housing For The Future and helping bring Shirley Daley Senior Village to life!

Participants gain valuable knowledge through structured courses that focus on:

- Understanding personal credit —building, repairing & strengthening scores
- Creating & managing a household budget
- Selecting and working with lenders and real estate professionals
- The loan and closing process and what to expect
- Basic home repair, maintenance, and budgeting for the future

New Lima – Housing for the Future has been providing the administrative support for the First Home Lima program since 2009 and in that time has assisted **123 low-to-moderate income households** accomplish their dream of homeownership!

Property Maintenance Training Course:

A Required Component of the First Home Lima Down Payment Assistance Program

The Property Maintenance Training course is a vital educational requirement within the First Home Lima Down Payment Assistance Program. This informative, three-hour session is designed to prepare first-time homebuyers for the responsibilities of homeownership — with a focus on proactive maintenance, budgeting for future repairs, and protecting long-term investment in the home.

This mandatory training, alongside the broader First Home Lima educational curriculum, is aimed at building confident, informed homeowners and reducing the risk of foreclosure. Together, these efforts support lasting homeownership success and neighborhood stability!
