

Why YAHUAH Uses Time as a Teaching Tool

Why does YAHUAH care about days on a calendar?

YAHUAH uses **time** to teach His people **how to live**, not just **what to believe**.

Time creates rhythm.

Time Was Created for Instruction

From the beginning, time was not random.

Bereshit (Genesis) 1:14

This means:
