

# **The Messiah Did Not End the Covenant He Renewed It**

Family, the Messiah did not come to cancel the covenant.

Yahusha said:

He was speaking to a covenant people who had become scattered, confused, and disconnected from Torah life.

He didn't come to replace Israel.  
He came to call people back into covenant alignment.

## **What Is Happening Now**

So what's happening now is something Scripture already described:  
A regathering of hearts.  
A refining of lives.  
A return to clean living, truth, and obedience.  
Not the forming of a new religion  
but a return to covenant order.

## **The Purpose of the Restored People**

Scripture says this restored people have a purpose.

“I will give you as a light to the nations.” Isaiah 49:6  
“Out of Zion shall go forth Torah.” Isaiah 2:3

Meaning:

- live the covenant
- walk in righteousness
- teach by example
- restore truth
- bring healing and order into the world

This calling is not about race.  
It is about covenant life.  
Anyone who walks in the covenant becomes part of the people who reflect His ways.

The Time We Are In

So what time are we in?

The prophets describe it as:

- a returning time
- a refining time
- a heart-awakening time
- a separating-from-wrong-ways time

Before a fuller season of restoration.

### The Simple Truth

The Messiah restored access to covenant life.

People are now being called to walk it.

The covenant did not stop.

It moved from stone into people.

And what YAHUAH is raising up is not a political group...

But a people who live clean, walk humbly, love justice, and teach truth by example.

A living Torah people

“...do justice, love mercy, walk humbly...”

Supports lifestyle description

**Deuteronomy 30:6**

“...circumcise your heart... to love YAHUAH...”

Supports heart awakening

**Covenant**

A relationship agreement established by YAHUAH that includes instruction, identity, and purpose.

**Torah**

Means *instruction* and guidance for living in alignment with YAHUAH’s design.

**Restoration**

Returning to covenant living, truth, and obedience after separation.

**Renewal**

Not replacement but restoration and internalization.
