Covenant Established

At Sinai – Torah Given

Narration Script:

YAHUAH entered covenant with Israel.
Not religion covenant.
Torah was given.
Identity was defined.
Obedience was life.

Exodus 19–24

Comfort & Complacency

They settled.
They prospered.
They became comfortable.
Gratitude turned into routine.

Deuteronomy 8:11–14
“Beware lest you forget...”

Blending with the Nations

They did not drive out the nations.
They began adopting customs.
Slowly — identity blurred.

Judges 2:11–13
Psalm 106:35
“They mingled among the nations...”

This is where:

- Foreign worship enters
- Foreign feast days enter
- Cultural blending replaces covenant obedience

Idolatry & Substitution

They replaced covenant loyalty
With visible substitutes.

It was never sudden rebellion.
It was gradual substitution.

2 Kings 17
Jeremiah 2

Judgment & Scattering

Assyria.
Babylon.
Rome.
Dispersion.

Covenant broken so protection lifted.

Deuteronomy 28

Crying Out & Partial Return

In captivity they remembered.
In crisis they returned.

Nehemiah 8
Daniel 9

But history shows something important:

Return was often incomplete.
