Amish Country Market at the Feed Mill 7301 Nolensville Road

The Nolensville Feed Mill, originally known as the Nolensville Mill Company, dates back to 1890 when a group of stockholders purchased and moved the mill to Nolensville. It began as a 50-barrel flour mill with a 48-inch grinding stone. Over the years, ownership changed hands, including Dr. David Rice Gooch, S. C. Battle, Owen Allen Gooch, and later his son David Allen Gooch, Mark Stinson, and the current owner, Darin Scheff. The original mill burned in 1933 and was rebuilt, but due to decreased demand for flour, it primarily focused on manufacturing feed. Today, it operates as an Amish Country Market, showcasing a variety of Amish food products and local goods, according to its website and other resources.

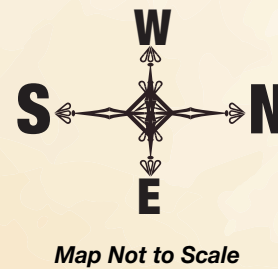

A Homeplace Bed & Breakfast

7286 Nolensville Road
This original Nolen home was built by the husband of Emily Nolen Barnes who was William Nolen's daughter. Later, it was known as the Stagecoach Inn. In the early mid-20th century, the Putnam family lived in the home and operated a store next-door. Bought at auction in 1989, the home in the historic district was restored and turned into a lovely bed-and-breakfast

Nolen House

7265 Nolensville Road
Nolensville's namesake, William Nolen and his large family lived in the original log cabin in the early 1800s. The home was moved in 2009 to save it from demolition. It was restored and the home is now occasionally rented for special events. Part of the original log cabin is encased on display.

The Morton Brittain House

9927 Sam Donald Court
The Morton Brittain house was slated for demolition when the Nolensville Historical Society and community banded together to move the 1870 home from Nolensville Road to the historic district in 2019. The community is invited inside during this year's festival, to see the progress of the renovation.

TC Ozment House

9927 Sam Donald Court
Built in the 1800s, this home was bought by the TC Ozment family in 1942. It's artesian well, with a pump built by Ozment, supplied water to local businesses. The home was restored and is now used as commercial offices for Dugger Realty, Nolensville Insurance - Dugger Agency, Southern Land Title & Escrow, Angela Dugger Photography and Designed Identities - Creative Studio.

StillWater

7292 Nolensville Road

Built in the 1880s, the StillWater building has been a cornerstone of the Nolensville community for well over a century. Once serving as the town's General Store and Post Office through the mid-1900s, and evolved with the times housing a restaurant and retail shops. Today, it's home to StillWater, a luxury boutique offering goods for men, women, and the home, all while honoring the rich history of the past.



Joe Jenkins House

7326 Nolensville Road

Joe and Hallie Sue Smith Jenkins home, son of Sherwood Green and Charlotte Fowlkes Jenkins (the Wilson's on corner of Clovercroft and Nol Rd) Hallie Sue's parents lived across the road. The house still has the tree trunks under it that were cut to build the house! Today, the house is home to Derek Simmons - State Farm Agency.
